Discussion and possible Adoption by Intergovernmental Relations Committee of its Work Plan and Goals for 2010-11.

Vice President London noted the Intergovernmental Relations Committee has not held committee meetings often this year. She said the reason was partly out of regard to the reduction in staff and no one has been appointed to the committee as the liaison. She said the District has hired representatives in Sacramento and Washington, D.C. who are tracking legislation.
