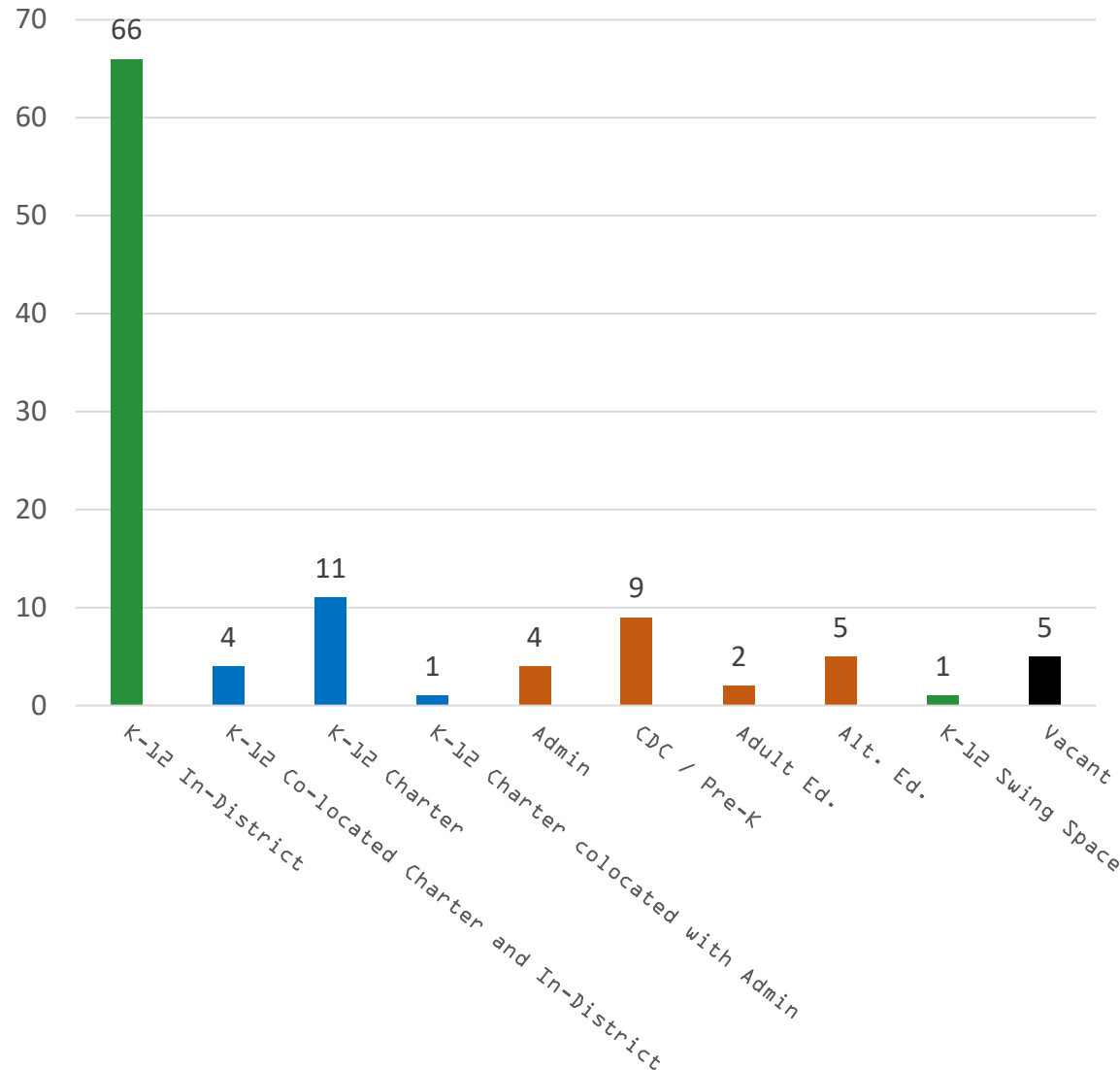

Why is a Site Disposition Process important to the Master Plan?

- The Master Plan must be prepared to respond to a dynamic and changing set of school programs and sites.
- To provide smart and consistent capital investments, the Master Plan must be informed by as many anticipated changes as possible.

Sites hosting K-12 In-District Programs:

Addressed by Blueprint

Sites hosting K-12 Charters:

OUSD to pursue long term leases for sites ideal for charter use

Sites hosting Admin/Operations:

OUSD to consolidate Admin/Operations activities to reduce expenses

Other sites:

OUSD to evaluate whether programs are good long term fit for each site and evaluate revenue generation opportunities

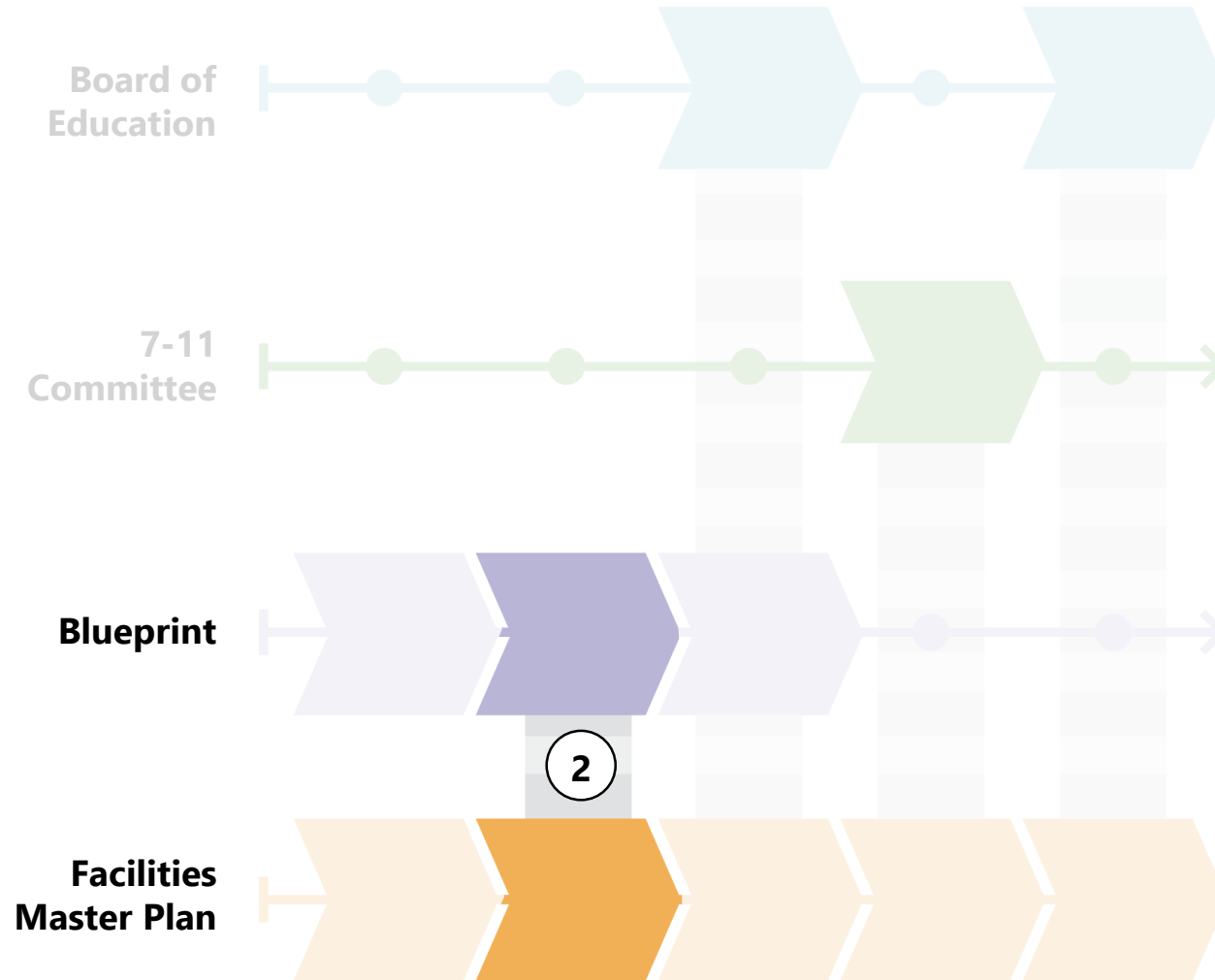

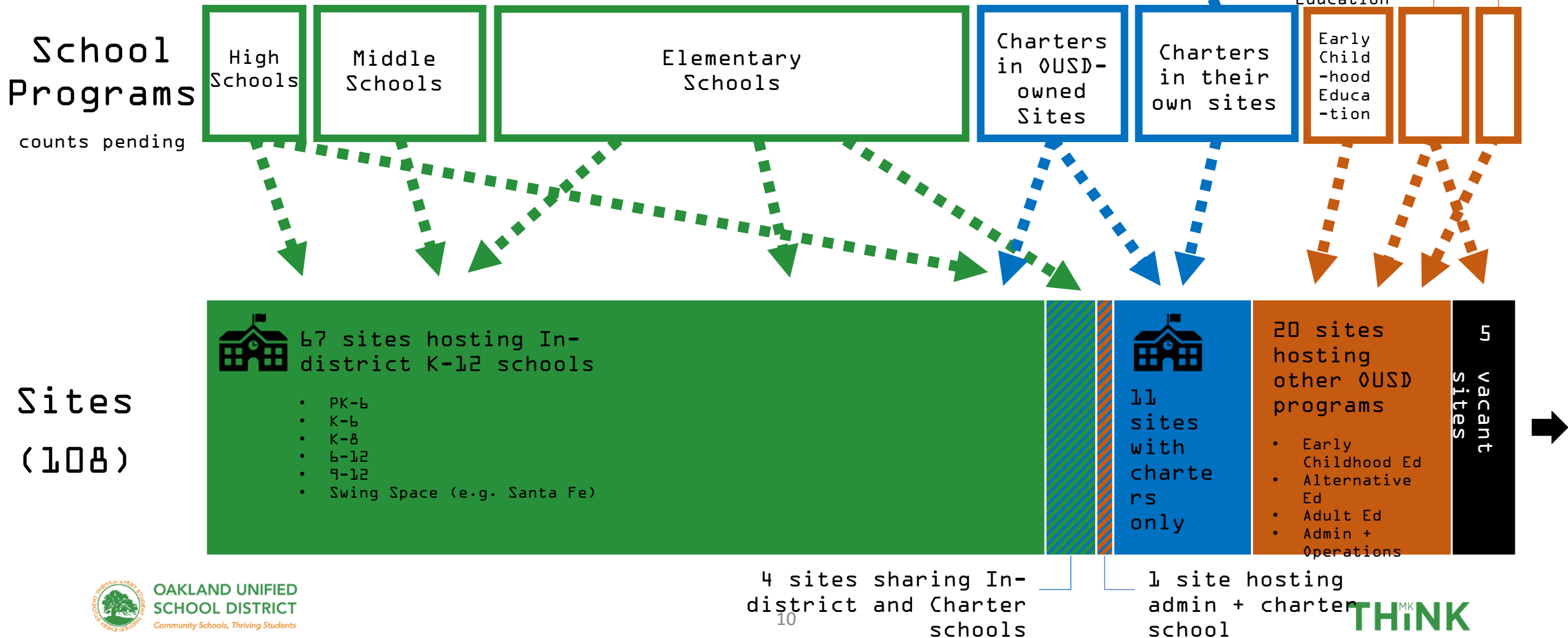

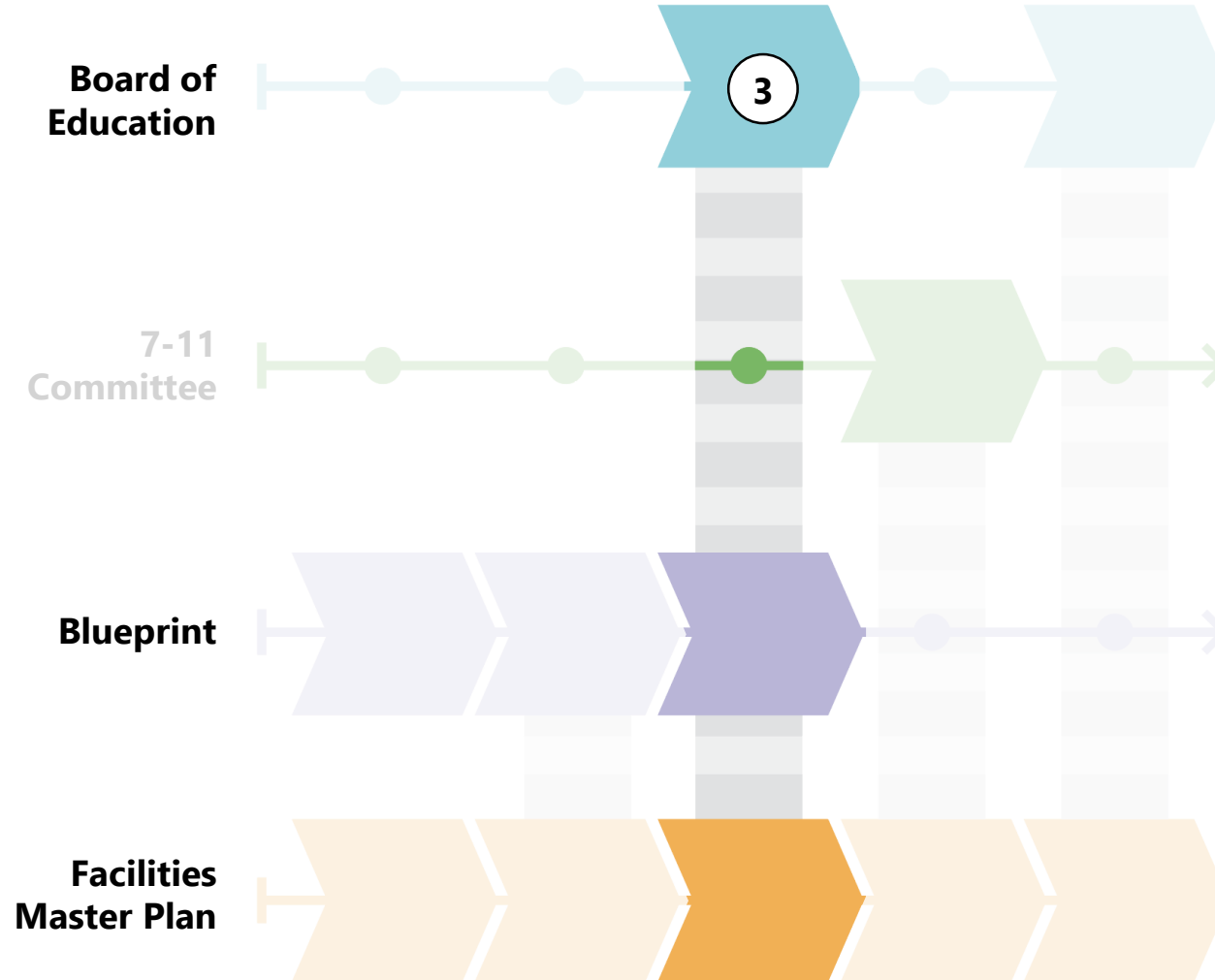
Facilities defines suitable uses for each site & collaborates with Blueprint planning team to recommend proposes future site uses to Board of Education

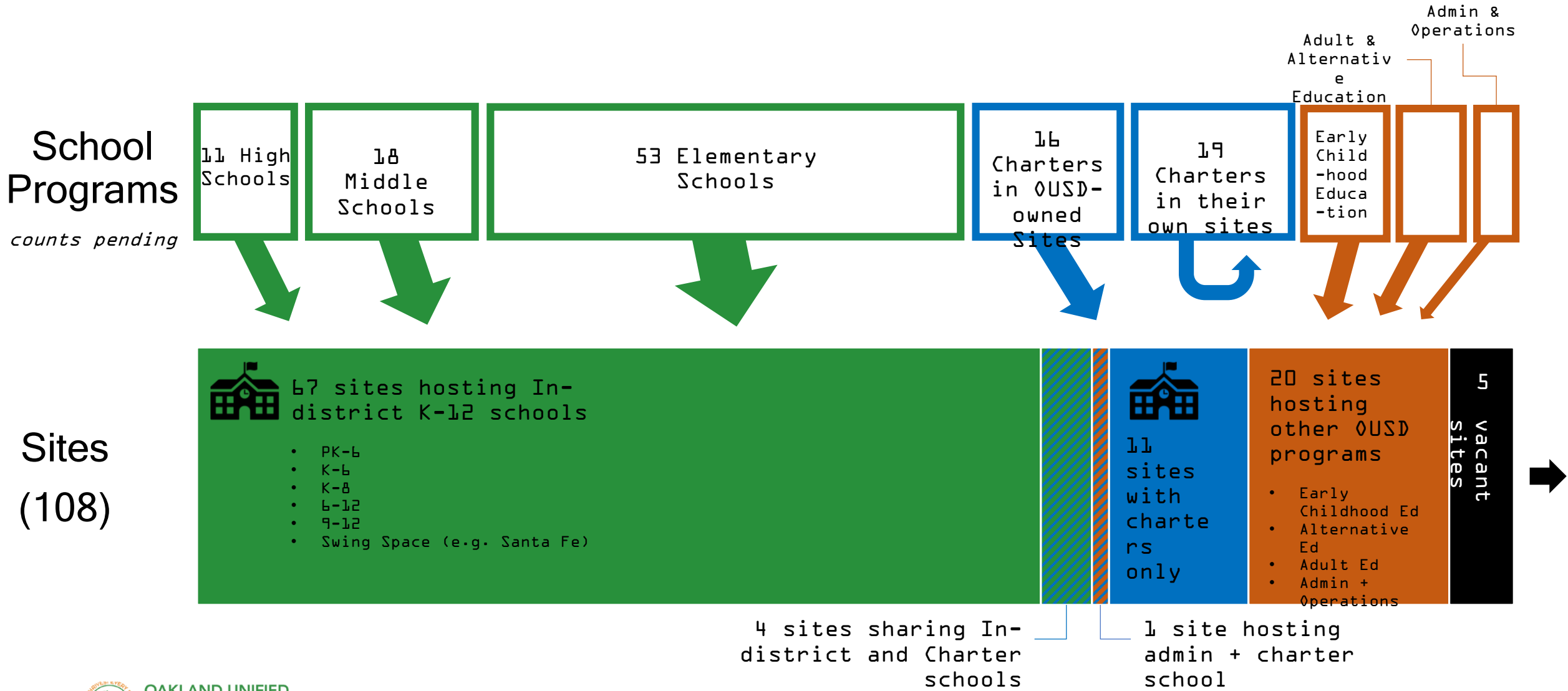

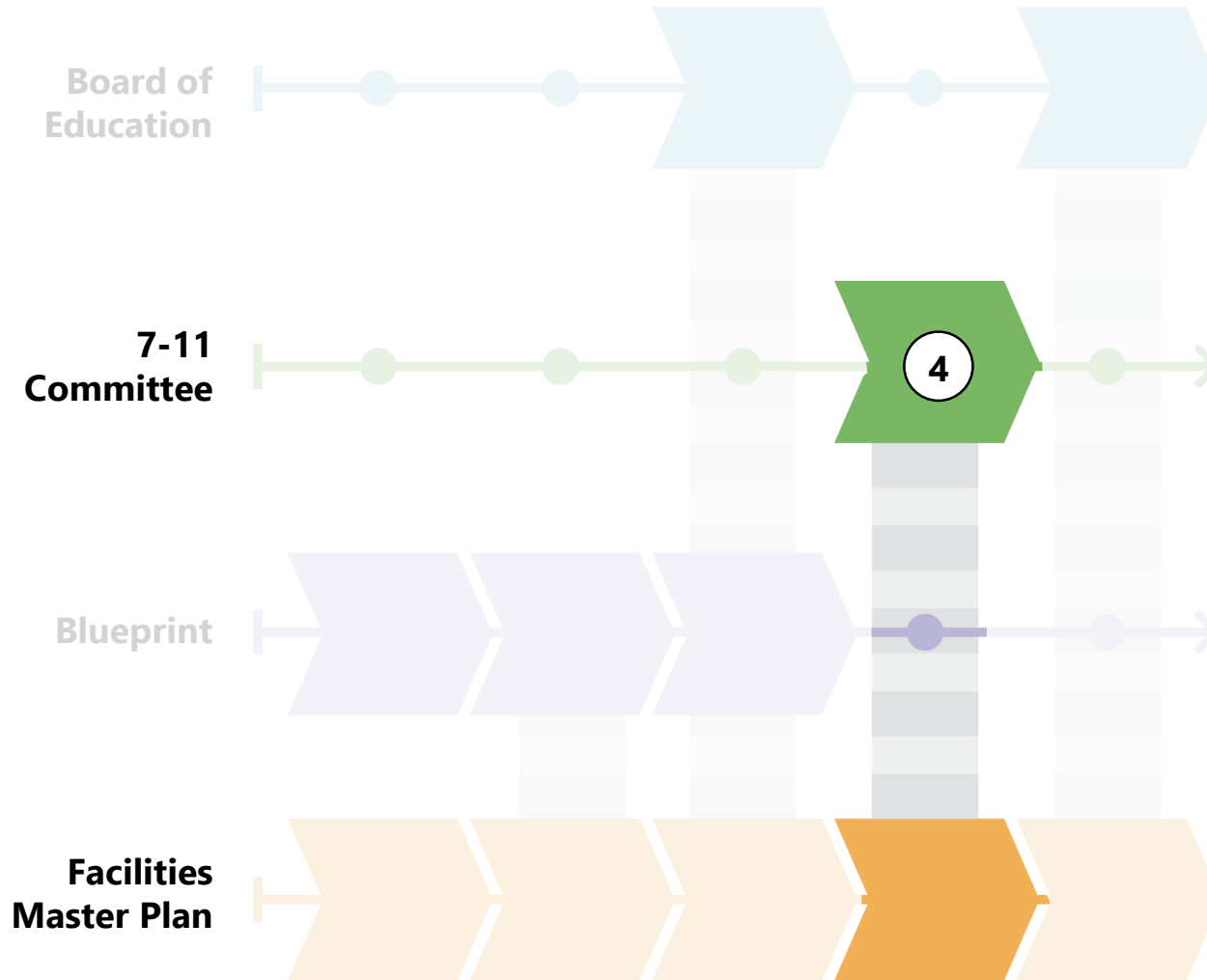
Finalized Uses (Showing 2019-2020 school year)

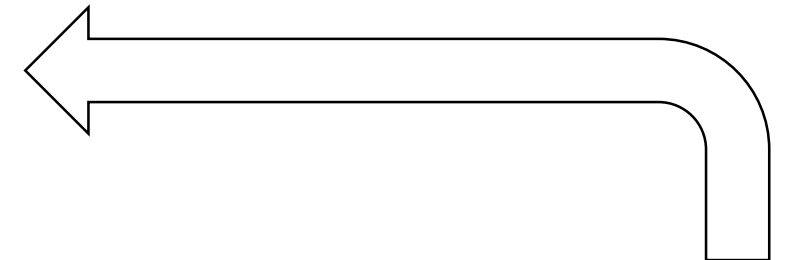

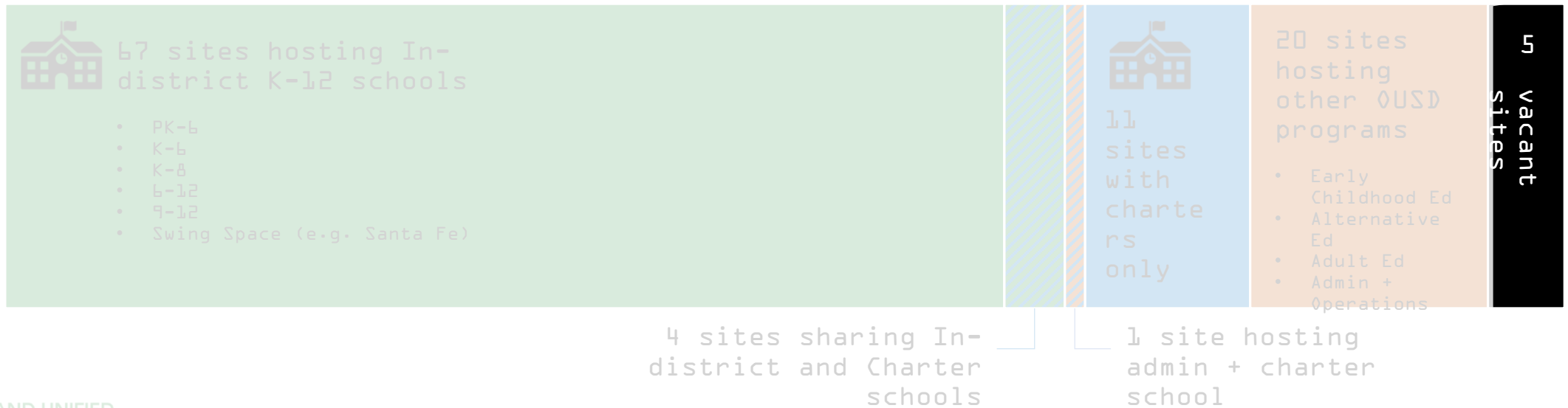

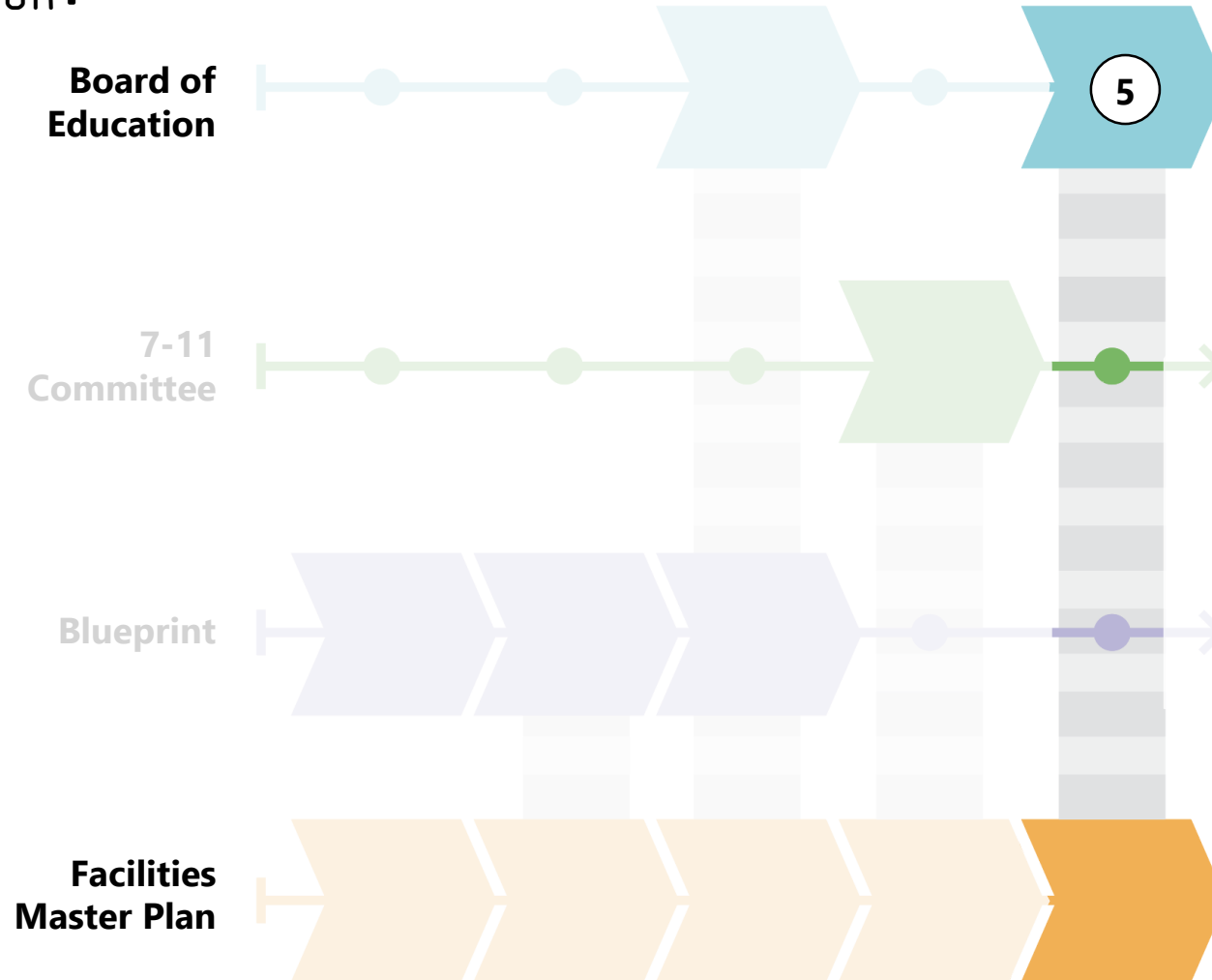

The Board of Education may decide to use vacant properties for other uses, including revenue generation.

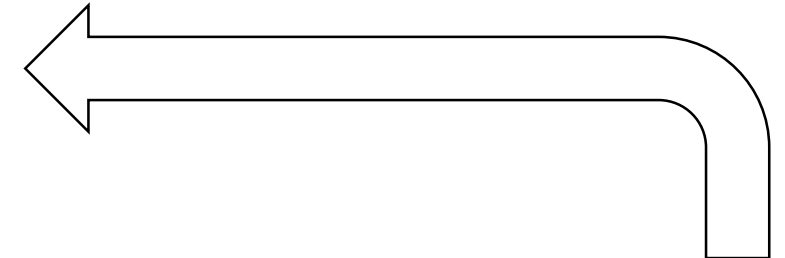

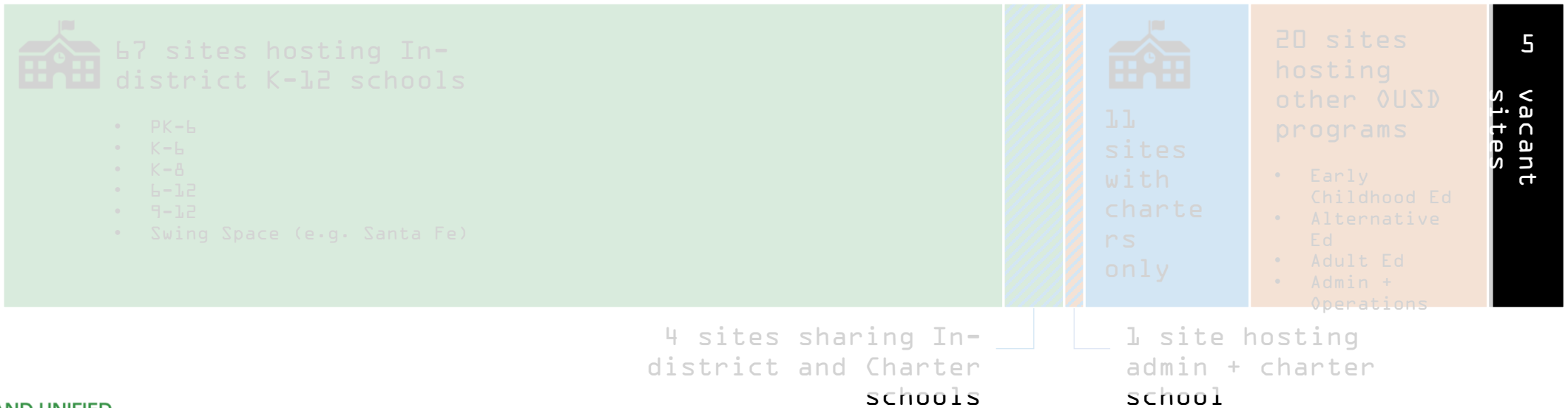
