Action Requested Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2122-0143
Declaring District Personal Property Obsolete, Surplus, and Authorizing
Disposition Thereof - Vehicles.

Background Following a routine review of vehicles, some Warehouse vehicles were
the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools that such items be
declared surplus and sold in accordance with Education Code sections
17545 and 17546, respectively.

Recommendation Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2122-0143
Authorization to Declare Obsolete Equipment Surplus Property and
Authorizing Sale.

Fiscal Impact Sale of the items listed in Exhibit "A" will reduce the cost associated with
the vehicles' financial returns on an item that would otherwise generate a
cost to the district for disposal.

Declaring District Personal Property Obsolete, Surplus, and Authorizing Disposition Thereof - Vehicles

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the Board of Education passed Resolution No. 1920-0260- George Floyd Resolution to Eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department, which directed the Superintendent to take the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department prior to January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible and to ensure that the District will eliminate the sworn law enforcement employees of the Oakland School Police Department; and other department vehicles determined to be obsolete and/or surplus to current District needs; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2020 the Board of Education passed Resolution 2021-0127- George Floyd District Safety Plan (Phase I) that identified the steps necessary to eliminate the Oakland Schools Police Department by January 1, 2021 or as soon thereafter as legally permissible; and other department vehicles determined to be obsolete and/or surplus to current District needs; and

WHEREAS, the District will no longer employ law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has received a list of Oakland Schools Police Department personal property – i.e. vehicles listed in Exhibit “A” deemed no longer required for school purposes or that is unsatisfactory or not suitable for school use; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent recommends that the Board declare said District personal property listed in Exhibit “A” to be obsolete, surplus and for items to be disposed of pursuant to applicable law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby declares said District personal property listed in attached Exhibit A to no longer be required for school purposes or is unsatisfactory or not suitable for school use; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs the Superintendent or designee to dispose of each item of the District’s personal property listed in attached Exhibit “A” and/or by sale, donation to a charitable organization or disposition in the local public dump upon compliance with the provisions of Education Code section 17445 and 17446, respectively.
