Measure B or J Bond Language Allow for Expenditures on Projects

That Were Not Specifically Listed in the Bond (8/17/16)

Joe Dominguez, Deputy Chief of Facilities, made the staff presentation.

Former General Counsel, Jacqueline Minor, prepared a written response to the inquiry made by the Committee regarding whether the Bond Language in Measure B and Measure J allowed for expenditures on the District's Facility Project List not specifically listed in the Bond. Deputy Chief Dominguez said he reviewed the response and followed up with Bond Counsel. He said Bond Counsel agreed with the legal analysis.

In an August 3rd letter from the District's General Counsel, it stated that the the Committee Chair requested a legal opinion as to whether Measure B and Measure J language allows for expenditures on projects not listed in the Bond language.

Chairperson Bierbaum clarified that this request was first made at the April 2016 Committee Meeting. She stated there were two open question from the last meeting; 1) Financial reconciliation; and 2) Statement of Compliance.

Vice Chair Dawson asked for a report from staff on how Measures B and Measure J funds were realigned? What was the process to defund some project? Was the intent to redirect funds to a new Administration Building or the purchase of commercial property?

Dominguez said he will provide a summer bond project update at the next meeting.

Vice Chair Dawon expressed concerns about Hoover School and other schools may not be safe. She asked why they didnt have security?

David Colbert was commended by the Committee for his patience with so many changes in the Annual Report.

After a discussion regarding the written response, Committee Members voted to approve the 2014/2015 Annual Report.

Chairperson Bierbaum led the discussion stating the goal for the Committee's website is for it to be more public friendly, enhancing communication and transparency. The website will feature the Measures A, B and J Independent Citizens' School Facilities Bond Oversight Committee 2014/2015 Annual Report, upcoming dates for ribbon cutting ceremonies, and dates for smaller celebrations at school sites.

Chairperson Bierbaum said the website is up and Committee Members gave feedback to the Chair.

Committee Members brainstormed other channels for putting out the Annual Report such as Facebook, hard copies for parents, and registered voters.

Dominguez stated that his goal is to enhance transparency. The Facilities Department wants to have ribbon cutting ceremonies for completed projects inviting Bond Oversight Committee Members in partnership with Superintendent and the Board. Smaller projects will have smaller celebrations.

Committee Member Swayne said the District should do a better job of letting the community know about events. She suggested that John Sasaki from the Communications Department should come to Committee Meetings. She stated there are a lot of good things happening in the District, but the District does a poor job of letting people know.

Vice Chair Dawson suggested posting a sign at the sites that say "Your Bond Money at Work" working with the Communications and Community Engagement Staff.

Committee Member Escalante discussed the importance of celebrating successes, even the small ones. It promotes good will, especially if the District needs to go out for bond money again.

Dominguez said he is working on signage with District Communication Department. They are updating the Facilities website by Friday and will put up photos of the projects. Dominguez said he is meeting with the Committee Chairperson once a month. Said he will be the point person on agenda items and will follow up internally to facilitate communication, response, time and clarity.

Committee Member Green asked about the process for making a request, how could it be considered official and deserving of a response? Did it need to be in writing? In the minutes?

Dominguez said a majority of the Committee was needed to have a formal request responded to.

Report - Dr. Marcus Foster Education Leadership Campus Project

Presentation of a Report from staff to the Measures A, B, and J Independent Citizens' School Facilities Bond Oversight Committee regarding whether any Bond funds - Measures A, B or J, - have been used or are projected or scheduled for use, if any, in the construction of the proposed Dr. Marcus Foster Education Leadership Campus.

Deputy Chief Dominguez updated the Committee on the Measure J funds used so far for the Marcus Foster Education Leadership Campus Project and the Dewey Campus. Immediately after the 2013 flood of the 1025 2nd Avenue Administration Building, \$487,000 were used for the following purposes:

- -a) Architectural and Engineering services \$247,000
- -b) Custodial services (clean and property watch) \$12,900
- -c) Interim housing for staff relocation \$32,000
- -d) Community Engagement Component- \$195,000

Dominguez reported no Measure J funds have been spent on the 1025 2nd Avenue and the Ethel Moore Building, but there are projected Measure J funds to be spent on the following:

- A site survey for 1025 2nd Avenue Building and the Ethel Moore Building to determine the property lines.
- Abatement work not done after the 2013 flood of the 1025 2nd Avenue Building must be completed.
- Architectural rendering of what the remodel will look like for 1025 2nd Avenue Building and, the Ethel Moore Building, and proposed plans for a multi-purpose room for Dewey High School.
- 2014 both buildings were to be demolished. Since then, the historical value has been put on both buildings. The District is working with a historical consultant to assess the historical value of both buildings and the available options for the District.
- Current plans call for an extreme make-over of both buildings; the knock down of non low-bearing walls; and opening up the office space with more cubicles and shared space.
- Not all employees will fit into 1025 2nd Avenue and the Ethel Moore Building. Lakeview is being used as an annex and may kept for that purpose.

Dominguez said the Board of Education has directed to obtain cost estimates for the Dewey Building, the Marcus Foster Education Leadership Campus at 1025 2nd Avenue and the Ethel Moore Building and to continue looking at private property and commercial office space the District can acquire for potential use.

Directive from Board:

- 1. Determine cost estimates for Dewey and Marcus Foster housed at 1025 2nd Avenue and Ethel Moore.
- 2. Look for a commercial office space for District to acquire.

Vice Chair Dawson asked if there is Bond money approved for the purchase by the Board?

Dominguez said they are at beginning stages. Looking at 1025 2nd Avenue and Ethel

Moore Building. Board has not directed one way or the other. Parking is also an issue.

Committee Member Swayne asked if you can challenge or appeal "historical value?"

Dominguez said they are looking at the cost associated with challenging with a consultant. In 2014, the plan was to demolish Dewey then the historic value came up.

Vice Chair Dawson asked if it had been landmarked.

Dominguez said he did not know.

Vice Chair Dawson said the historic value could be challenged and then it can be renovated. It doesn't have to be landmarked.

Dominguez said staf is looking at cost estimates and cost for ADA compliance and structural assessment.

Committee Member Teng expressed concern that nowhere in bond language does it say that the funds can be used administration facilities. Containing it within Dewey does not make it fit.

Chairperson Bierbaum said language on page 4 on the Bond Language allows funds can used for renovation of those buildings.

Vice Chair Dawson asked had a consultant been hired? How is this being paid for? Is it a District employee? Are bond funds being used?

Dominguez said he and staff within the District are working on this.

Committee Member Swayne said the Committee wishes that no bond funds be used to acquire property.
