The five Intensive Support Schools serve 2,000 low-income students, a majority of whom cannot read at grade level and will not graduate ready for college or career.

This is a complex process, and will need to be adjusted based on school community contexts. These schools have been through many changes. The most important outcome now is that our students receive a great education. We all share that responsibility.

I write to support your leadership in four areas:

- 1) Teachers deserve the biggest possible raise. Oakland teachers are among the lowest paid in the country. Teacher turnover harms our students. Let's take the necessary steps to conclude the contract negotiations quickly so that educators can focus on the difficult work of teaching.
- 2) Schools deserve intensive support for bold transformation when they are struggling. Low-performing schools need the best leadership, experience, and designs available.
