CSEA proposes to amend the following articles:

Article 5/Appendix A - Salary Compensation, to ensure that bargaining unit members receive a fair and equitable increase in salary to a level that is comparable to similarly situated officers' pay, improve longevity incentives, and to establish additional steps on the salary scale.

Article 6 - Hours of Employment, to create a more appropriate and desirable work shifts.

Article 9 - Health and Welfare Benefits, to ensure that bargaining unit members receive a fair and equitable increase in employer contributions for health and welfare benefits. Additionally, CSEA seeks to decrease or eliminate the six month probation period for effective date of new member's health coverage.
