I. Superintendent of Schools or Designee's Committee Liaison Report

Timothy White, Assistant Superintendent, Facilities Planning and Management, said the District is only 27 days away from the opening of school. Mr. White reported across the District extensive site improvements this summer to bring a uniform facilities standard to every community.

Summer Improvements

- 1. New playground equipment installed.
- 2. New portable buildings installed.
- 3. Modernization at some schools.

Mr. White said he hopes there is an orderly opening of school and the students find the schools in better condition than when they left them. Mr. White provided the Committee with a list of summer project in June; he said at the next Facilities Committee Meeting he will provide an update of the improvements.

Board Member Comments

Vice President London wanted to know if the new portables met the District's CHPS criteria?

Mr. White said the portables in most cases do not meet CHPS criteria but new construction do meet CHPS criteria. He said the District's desire is not to have portable buildings.

Director Spearman commented on the work at La Escuelita Elementary School. She said she is pleased at the progress and wanted to know the expected date the students occupy the building?

Mr. White said the building started going vertical two weeks ago with a 60% Oakland workforce. He said Phase I is scheduled to be completed late next year.

Chairperson Gallo requested Mr. White have one on one conversations with all Board

Members beginning with Facility Committee Members. He said the purpose of the conversations will be to discuss the many improvements and the needs in their neighborhood schools; to listen and get feedback in terms of what Board Member's expectations may be or actions for considerations pertaining to:

The Asset Management Study

The progress and direction of the Facility Master Plan [timeline and action plan] The current funding streams to make these improvements and what the needs may be in the immediate future.

Chairperson Gallo requested Mr. White get input from each Board Member and have a Board action direction presentation in terms of where the future lies with the District to continue the progress.

Chairperson Gallo said Mr. White has done an outstanding job. He said what Oakland has done in terms of improvements and building new schools is great. He said the District is grateful to the voters of Oakland.
