

Removing her would be incredibly disruptive, even damaging, to the greater Sequoia community, especially during these extremely difficult financial times when Wendy is increasingly called on to fulfill even more roles than ever before.

Wendy is not just a secretary. She has been an essential member of this community for 30 years, shepherding three kids and two grandkids through the ranks. She has worked at Sequoia as a noon supervisor, attendance clerk and secretary for a total of 24 years of outstanding service. Thanks to her 30 year relationship with Sequoia she has an intimate knowledge of Sequoia families. Not only does she know our students intimately, but she is on a first name basis with a vast majority of Sequoia parents and extended family members.

Wendy is not just a secretary. In addition to the intense demands of her secretarial duties, she also serves in many other capacities. She is the school nurse, handling everything from bloody noses to ice packs to asthma medication. She is the ad hoc school counselor, providing social and emotional support for students who need a break. She is the social coordinator, keeping track of birthdays, births, etc., helping to build and maintain a social network at Sequoia which makes teachers and staff feel supported, motivated and valued. Because of Wendy's encyclopedic knowledge of Sequoia, she is the go-to person for every single question.

Wendy is not just a secretary. She is an excellent office manager. Due to her superb organizational skills and time management, as well as her hard work and dedication, Wendy is able to do so much more than is expected of her. This allows her to interact with students on a personal basis.

Wendy is not just a secretary. She is a neighbor, a friend, a parent, a grandparent, and the absolute heart of Sequoia. Sequoia's growing reputation as a successful school is due in large part to the strong community, of which Wendy is the backbone. We, the staff, are vehemently opposed to the district's abhorrent plan to displace Wendy from the Sequoia family.
