OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING DISTRICT'S SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS OR INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2011-2012

To all interested parties, please take notice that on October 12, 2011, the Oakland Unified School District, at a Regular Meeting of the Governing Board ("Board"), will hold a public hearing on its proposed finding of Sufficiency of Textbooks or Instructional Materials for School Year 2011-2012.

The public hearing will be held, October 12, 2011, at 2:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Auditorium, Castlemont High School, 8601 MacArthur Boulevard, Oakland, CA 94605. The purpose of the hearing is for the Board to determine in writing whether each pupil in each school in the District has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards, adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education:

Mathematics; Science; History-Social Science; and English Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of the adopted program.

The Board, at the hearing, also will determine in writing whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course, if applicable, has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curiculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education for those subjects. The Board, at the hearing, will further determine in writing the availability of laboratory science equipment for science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive.

Parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district and bargaining unit leaders are encouraged to participate in this hearing.

California Education Code Section 60119 requires that the Board hold this annual public hearing, inparticular, to determine the sufficiency of textbooks or instructional materials for each pupil in each school in order to be eligible to receive funds for the purposes mentioned in the second paragraph of this notice. The provision of the textbooks, instructional materials, or science equipment specified in paragraph three of this notice is not a condition of the receipt of funds provided under the Pupil Textbook and Instructional Materials Incentive Program.
