SUBJECT: Resolution Number 1112-0028 for Non-Public Schools and Non-Public Agencies Contracts for the 2011-2012 School Year

ACTION REQUESTED

Approval of Resolution Number 1112-0028 to allow the District to enter into and execute revised, amended, or new master contracts for Non-Public Schools and Non-Public Agencies for Special Education Programs for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 and to enter into and execute revised, amended or New Individual Service Agreements for Special Education students for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 in an amount not to exceed \$18,000,000.00.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Federal Law and California Education Code require a Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) to provide a full continuum of program options, to include Non-Public Schools (NPS). When a school district or SELPA does not have an appropriate public education program for a student, a non-public school and/or the services of a non-public agency shall be made available. The District places students in a NPS for services such as: Day Treatment, Residential Treatment, extreme behaviors and severely disabled students. The District utilizes non-public agency services to supplement in-house staff services such as speech and language therapy and behavior specialists.

This Resolution Number 1112-0028 is necessary to meet the educational needs of students needing specialized care as deemed through their Individual Education Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT


The total cost for the Master Agreements and Individual Service Agreements for services to Special Education students utilizing Non-Public Schools and Non-Public Agencies, funded by Programs for Exceptional Children for Fiscal Year 2011-2012, is projected to not exceed \$18,000,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval of Resolution Number 1112-0028 to allow the District to enter into and execute revised, amended, or new master contracts for Non-Public Schools and Non-Public Agencies for Special Education Programs for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 and to enter into and execute revised, amended or New Individual Service Agreements for Special Education students for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 in an amount not to exceed \$18,000,000.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Board approves a Master Agreement or Contract, subject to form and content approval by the General Counsel with each Non-Public School or Non-Public Agency listed in Attachments "A" and "B" respectively, and further authorizes Individual Service Agreements to be issued, subject to approval by Board, subject to form and content approval by the General Counsel, in a total amount Not To Exceed \$18,000,000.00, for the fiscal year 2011-2012.
