TRIAL ON-LINE SPEAKER CARD REGISTRATION

The Measures B, J, and Y Independent Citizens' School Facilities Bond Oversight Committee, in its desire to take more targeted Public Comment on Agenda Items, on a trial basis, within the current times allotted for Public Comment, is returning to it past practice of taking individual Public Comment on most items on the Agenda (except Consent). As a result, a separate Speaker Card (Request To Speak) is required to be filed by the commenter on each Agenda Item eligible for Public Comment.

Your First Name and Last Name, as Registered, must also show as the Participant or Profile Name on a teleconference system (i.e., zoom, webex, other). You will be requested to Register the first time you use the eComment - Request To Speak.
