Registering to Speak (electronic or paper) for any and all Agenda Items for this meeting, preferably, must be received by the Commission staff or the presiding officer by the time the Commission has reached this point "C" in the Agenda of the meeting but not later than BEFORE an Agenda item is called for consideration by the presiding officer. A Registration to Speak submitted after the item has been called will be "filed."

Modification(s) to the Agenda allows for any change in the printed order of business including, but not limited to, an announcement that an Agenda item or legislative file will be considered out of Agenda printed order, that consideration of an Agenda item has been withdrawn, postponed, rescheduled or "pulled" or taken off of the General Consent Report for separate discussion and/or possible action.
