Included in the proposed administrative regulations is a provision that when services are provided by OUSD employees and consultants not paid by the Measure N 10% allowable administrative cost account, costs for such services are calculated as accurately as possible and charged by OUSD to charter high schools or charter management organizations. If such services are provided by employees and consultants paid by the Measure N 10% allowable administrative cost account, charter high schools and charter management organizations should not be charged for such services rendered.
