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Updates

Program of Study

- Ninth grade: BUILD Engineering, English 9, Biology, Integrated Math 1, Ethnic Studies, and Advisory
- Tenth Grade: PLTW Introduction to Engineering Design, English 10, Chemistry, Integrated Math 2, U.S. History, and Advisory
- Eleventh Grade: Intermediate Engineering Design for Social Change, English 11, Integrated Math 3, World History, and Advisory
- Twelfth Grade: Engineering Design Capstone, English 12, Statistics, Government/Economics, College & Career Readiness, and Advisory



Structural Shifts in Support of Pathways

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- Redesigned CTE sequence so that all CTE courses are focused on Engineering Design.
- Added new Dean from Maker Ed with content expertise.
- Regular meetings with pathway development team.
- Redesigned professional development time to allow for grade level collaboration and interdisciplinary planning.
- Whole staff PD on Measure N and Linked Learning; 1:1 and team coaching on implementing pathway theme.
- Weekly collaboration with pathway coach to support implementation.
- Actively hiring Pathway Coordinator.
- Added Dual Enrollment courses (Counseling 57 & Counseling 24) at 10th and 12th grade.
- Added schoolwide college visit day (post-secondary engineering and design programs).



CTE & Rigorous Academics Integration

- Re-design of CTE course sequence to focus on Engineering Design and Autodesk CAD programming.
- Adjusted partnership with BUILD to embed Engineering Design CTE standards.
- Participated in PBL Leadership Academy: PBL Training for team leads to support interdisciplinary project development in all grade levels.
- Collaboration with Advisory board to identify industry partners to support with interdisciplinary projects.
- Developed Senior Engineering Design Capstone.

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Deepening Work-Based Learning experiences across Pathways

- Integrated WBL into advisory program at each grade level.
- Implemented professional Speaker Series.
- Updated senior portfolio
- Collaboration with Advisory board to identify industry partners for mock interviews, informational interviews, project collaboration, and student project feedback.
- Partnership with Youth Uprising to connect students to internships in semester 2
- Partnership with Frog Design Firm to sponsor 9th grade BUILD Engineering and provide internships

- Collaborated with BUILD to facilitate formal pathway orientation for 9th grade students and families
- Interdisciplinary projects at all grade levels
- Peer Leadership (student ambassadors)
- Vertical and horizontal alignment for CTE courses
- Grade Level trips to engineering programs
- Developed new engineering courses
