The field trips will relate to pathway projects that will take the curriculum beyond the walls of the classroom. These trips include work based learning experiences, but also experiences related to integrated projects and career-technical education themed curriculum. This expenditure is aligned to the goal of increasing project-based learning components into pathway curricula and extending classroom work beyond the physical classroom. Engagement will increase through students being able to apply their classroom learnings and understandings to other contexts and transferring skills to different environments. 2021 Carryover Plan	N/A	N/A	<p>Conference Expenses: for 1 Teacher to attend the Engineer Your World Summer Curriculum training.</p> <p>In order to implement the Engineering Your World (EYW) 10th grade Introduction to Engineering Course, a teacher is required to take the summer training. The training is in Austin, TX and we will need to pay for airfare, lodging, and daily meal allocations. Students in Engineer Your World (EYW) courses develop engineering design skills, internalize engineering habits of mind, and explore the breadth of engineering professions. Students discover how engineering makes a difference in the world while completing hands-on challenges that illustrate how engineers: Collaborate to solve complex challenges; Employ a rigorous and creative design process; Engage in computational thinking; Make data-supported design decisions; and Develop solutions with customers in mind. Engineering Design and Analysis expands opportunities for all students by building creative problem-solving and engineering design skills; and creating a strong foundation for future STEM learning. This hands-on, team-based, inquiry-focused engineering design course provides meaningful learning experiences for students with diverse needs, interests, and learning styles. As the Innovative Design and Engineering Academy (IDEA) moves to a different focus within engineering and designing new CTE course sequences, we are no longer going to subscribe to the Project Lead the Way course offerings. Teachers are in the process of writing new course outlines for 11th and 12th grade with a focus on Universal Design. This will make the course content appealing and accessible to more students. The EYW course will fill the need for a new 10th grade course that will provide a foundation of engineering skills</p>	\$5,000.00

			<p>before students move into the higher level 11th and 12th grade engineering courses.</p> <p>We anticipate airfare costing about \$2,000.00 (round trip from Oakland to Austin, TX), lodging costing about \$3,000.00 (estimating 14 nights at \$200/night + taxes) and \$1,000 for meals and other travel related costs like car rental, for a total of \$6,000.00.</p>
