LISTENING TO STUDENT VOICES

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School Safety Survey

- High School Survey
 - We have collected 261 responses in total
 - 14 different schools responded to our survey
 - 100+ students said they don't feel safe at school
 - Many students mentioned how their school sites constantly has weekly fights and strangers coming into the schools
- Middle School Survey
 - There were technical difficulties so we are extending our middle school survey
 - We had 222 students respond to our survey
 - 13 different middle schools fill out our survey
 - SHOUTOUT TO ELMHURST UNITED FOR HAVING 191 STUDENT FILL OUT OUR SURVEY!
 - 102 students felt like they don't have an adult they can talk to at school
