- Both surveys have been extended
- High School Survey
 - We have collected 325 responses in total
 - 14 different schools responded to our survey
 - 175 students feel safer without police in their school
 - Top 3 things students wants to see in their schools are:

 - Wellness center space
 - Having Teacher that look and can relate to me
- Middle School Survey
 - We had 285 students respond to our survey
 - 14 different middle schools fill out our survey
 - 122 students feel safer without police in their schools

 - More Mental Health Services
 - Mask, hand sanitizer, tissue, etc


