

- There has been a new site leader on campus each year since the last EIP was drafted
- COVID interrupted what was an existing strong work-based learning program, but we're excited to bring it back!
 - Our juniors have their third on-site internship day this Thursday!
- We've <u>aligned on a pathway</u> (Software and Systems Development as of summer 2022) that is squarely in one industry sector, rooted in student interest, and motivated by the East Bay regional job outlook
- The importance of clear processes, goals, documentation, and accountability has been underlined and the development of these items prioritized

- Exciting next steps:
 - Continuing to build out our team's capacity and credentialing to support the pathway
 - o Documenting and maintaining our community partnerships, reinvigorated since the pandemic
 - Expanding dual enrollment offerings

- Anticipated challenging but necessary and still exciting work:
 - Teacher hiring it's real!
 - Pushing on Tier 1 instruction that is high-quality and interconnected

Focal Groups

- As a small school with a high level of expectations (all students by default are enrolled in courses needed to complete A-G requirements), a focus on pathway quality equates to a focus on instructional and programmatic improvement for all scholars
- When we think about our focus groups students with IEPs, African-American students, and multiracial students - we think about ensuring their voices are on our Steering Committee and ensuring they are centered in decision-making for the pathway and school community
