ACTION REQUESTED

Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1314-1073, for One (1) Certificate of Completion of Staff Development, Variable Term Waiver.

BACKGROUND

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) has the authority to issue waiver documents to allow employers to employ or assign persons who are not appropriately credentialed for a teaching and/or administrative assignment. Waivers are issued or denied based on the Commission's established criteria and factors such as an employer's continuing needs; the support the employer will provide to the applicant; or extenuating, extraordinary and unanticipated circumstances.

The Career Technical Education (CTE) Program Standards (2008) require preparation for teaching English Learners (EL) to be embedded in the preparation program. Therefore, the Clear CTE Credential authorizes teaching EL. With the Preliminary Credential, CTE Teacher candidates may teach while completing teacher preparation. However, the Preliminary Credential does not authorize teaching EL. Until all requirements for the Clear CTE Credential are completed, holders of the Preliminary CTE Credential may obtain a waiver annually for teaching EL as long as they are making progress toward completing the requirements.

DISCUSSION

The Board of Education, exercising the power of the Governing Board, may approve an application seeking a variable term waiver from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing as may be necessary for certain certificated employees of the District for a specific period of time, as follows:
