ACTION REQUESTED

Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1415-0086, for One Variable Term Waiver Request WV1.EC §44265 Professional Preparation Program for a Specialist Instruction Credential in Special Education.

BACKGROUND

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) has the authority to issue waiver documents to allow employers to employ or assign persons who are not appropriately credentialed for a teaching and/or administrative assignment. Waivers are issued or denied based on the Commission's established criteria and factors such as an employer's continuing needs; the support the employer will provide to the applicant; or extenuating, extraordinary and unanticipated circumstances.

The District currently faces a critical shortage of teachers who are fully credentialed to teach in Special Education classrooms.

The District has reviewed its staffing needs, conducted a diligent search for this position, and all attempts have been made to fill this position with an appropriately credentialed candidate.

A fully credentialed candidate was not available, and diligent search was conducted to recruit candidates in this order:

- A candidate who is scheduled to complete his or her preliminary credential requirements within six months
- A candidate who is qualified to participate and to enroll in an internship program
- A candidate who qualifies to use a local assignment option
- A candidate who qualifies for the Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) or the Short Term Staff Permit (STSP)

The District has been unable to find an individual who qualifies for one of the staffing options listed above, and a Variable Term Waiver Request WV1.EC §44265 Professional Preparation Program for a Specialist Instruction Credential in Special Education is being requested for the most qualified candidate.

Ms. Laird has completed a teacher preparation program in Education Specialist: Mild to Moderate Disabilities at Holy Names University, with a single remaining completion requirement for issuance of her Preliminary Education Specialist Credential of the Reading Instruction Competency Assessment (RICA). She has previously held a Short Term Staffing Permit, and does not qualify for a Provisional Internship Permit, because she has met subject matter competence for the credential. She has completed student teaching for the credential and is not eligible for an Internship Credential. She holds the degree Master of Education in Urban Education granted by Holy Names University.

DISCUSSION

The Board of Education, exercising the power of the Governing Board, may approve an application seeking a variable term waiver from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing as may be necessary for certain certificated employees of the District for a specific period of time, as follows:
