BUDGET DEVELOPMENT – COMPLETED

February 2015

- School Site Budgets:
 - Budget Development Tool available 2/2/2015
 - Training tools for site principals available when Tool was opened
 - School Site Councils have met to review and approve site budgets.
 - School sites "lock-in" sessions completed final trades and staffing decisions made
 - 79% of appeals were granted, resulting in over 59 teacher FTEs added to school budgets over the staffing formula (based on projected enrollment).
 - In addition 9 schools received loans that increased enrollment projections.
 - All school site budgets are in place for 2015-16
