BACKGROUND

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) has the authority to issue waiver documents to allow employers to employ or assign persons who are not appropriately credentialed for a teaching and/or administrative assignment. A Waiver is issued or denied based on the Commission's established criteria and factors such as an employer's continuing needs; the support the employer will provide to the applicant; or extenuating, extraordinary and unanticipated circumstances.

The District currently faces a critical shortage of teachers who are qualified to teach in Bilingual classrooms, and who can provide instruction in the primary language to Limited English Proficient students.

The District has reviewed its staffing needs, conducted a diligent search for this position, and all attempts have been made to fill this position with an appropriately credentialed candidate.

A fully credentialed candidate was not available, and diligent search was conducted to recruit candidates in this order:

- A candidate who is scheduled to complete his or her preliminary credential requirements within six months
- A candidate who is qualified to participate and to enroll in an internship program

- A candidate who qualifies to use a local assignment option
- A candidate who qualifies for the Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) or the Short Term Staff Permit (STSP)

The District has been unable to find an individual who qualifies for one of the staffing options listed above, and Emergency Bilingual Spanish Variable Term Waivers are being requested for the most qualified candidates.

DISCUSSION

The Board of Education, as the Governing Board, may approve an application seeking a Bilingual Cross-cultural, Language and Academic Development (BCLAD) — Spanish - Variable Term Waiver from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, as may be necessary for certain certificated employees of the District. For the 2015-2016 school year, a waiver is being sought for the following employees:

- 1. Leoncio Figueroa-Selgado, Multiple Subject Bilingual Spanish, Global Family, K-5
- 2. Victor Gudiol-Melero, BCLAD: Spanish, Manzanita Seed Elementary, K-5
- 3. Abel Guzman-Domenech, BCLAD: Spanish, Greenleaf, K-5
- 4. Eva Sivill-Marimon, BCLAD: Spanish, Global Family, K-5

Leoncio Figueroa-Selgado graduated in July 1983 from Centro Reginal de Educacion Normal, Iguala, Guerrero, Mexico, with a Bachelor's in Teacher, Elementary Education. He completed his Doctorate Program at LAVAL, Quebec, Canada, in January 2005 with a PhD in Psychopedagogy. This waiver will allow him to complete requirements for BCLAD: Spanish.

Victor Gudiol-Melero is a visiting teacher from Spain who graduated in 2009 from the University of the Balearic Islands with a Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education and a specialization in foreign language (English/Spanish) education.

Abel Guzman-Domenech is a visiting teacher from Spain who graduated in 2009 with a degree in Elementary Education and a Master's degree in Special Education.

Eva Sivill Marimon has met the CBEST requirement and CTEL 1. She needs additional time to complete requirements for completing BCLAD.
