Lodestar Charter School



Staff recommends that the OUSD Board of Education approve the petition for Lodestar to serve students in grades TK-12th and to begin operation as an OUSD authorized charter school on July 1, 2016.













Reasons for Approval of Lodestar

- Lighthouse Community Charter Schools (LCCS)
 operates two charter schools in Oakland (K-8/9-12)
- LCCS is funding <u>four (4) full time employees</u>
 (including teachers) <u>in Year 0</u> (2015-16)
- Personalized and differentiated courses of study through Common Core aligned "Learning Expeditions" and multi-age groupings
- Participated in/met all <u>OUSD Fall Call</u> requirements of charter schools











Areas of Concern to be Addressed

- Create a <u>plan</u> to address <u>high school</u>
 <u>persistence</u> at Lodestar in order to prevent replication of, and also address, the <u>low</u>
 <u>cohort graduation rate at Lighthouse</u>
 <u>Community Charter High School</u>.
- Required Text Revision- to state that the enrollment meeting is "optional."







"CONDITIONS ON OPENING"- Appendix II

Unified Enrollment

• Lodestar commits to participation in creating a unified recruitment and enrollment process* that ensures equitable access to educational opportunities for all students of all demographic backgrounds and academic abilities.

*At this time, Oakland Unified School District does not have a unified enrollment system, but should Oakland Unified School District adopt one, the expectation would be that Lodestar fully participate in the design of such a system.







"CONDITIONS ON OPENING"

Unified Enrollment

Lodestar commits to establishing recruitment and enrollment strategies that will support achieving a student demographic that is aligned to the demographics of Oakland.

Lodestar will align enrollment timelines with Oakland Unified School District enrollment due dates (i.e. application and enrollment packet submission dates).







"CONDITIONS ON OPENING"

Special Education

- Given the shared commitment of district-run and districtcharter schools to serve all students of all demographic backgrounds and academic abilities, Lodestar will partner with Oakland Unified School District to ensure that all families are aware of, and able to, access enrollment and a Free and Appropriate Public Education at Lodestar.
- Lodestar commits to targeted recruitment of students with severe disabilities, with the goal of more closely reflecting the percentage of Oakland Unified School District's severe special education population, which is 1.98% of total enrollment.









"CONDITIONS ON OPENING"

Expulsions

- Lodestar will provide advanced notification (in alignment with parent notification) of expulsion hearings to the Oakland Unified School District Office of Charter Schools, so that an Oakland Unified School District representative may attend.
- Lodestar will provide to the Oakland Unified School District
 Office of Charter Schools for review, all documentation of
 findings/evidence related to expulsions; including an audio or
 video recording, or authenticated written transcript, of the
 hearing. All documentation needs to be submitted to the
 Oakland Unified School District Office of Charter Schools
 within 1-2 business days of the expulsion hearing decision.







LODESTAR APPROVAL RECOMMENDATION

- Petition presents a sound educational program
- Petitioners are demonstrably likely to successfully implement the program set forth in the petition
- Petition contains the required signatures and affirmations
- Petition contains reasonably comprehensive descriptions of all of the 16 elements required by the California Charter Schools Act
