

# Turn-Out and Outcomes for the LCAP Advisory Committee Elections



- Elections for committee members were held on 10/14 and again on 10/21.
- By-laws requirement for elections quorum: SSC members from 60% of the schools in each electoral district must attend the elections.
- Quorum achieved in Districts 5, 6, and 7. All positions filled for those districts.
- Number of schools in attendance at the elections for remaining districts: D1 (4 of 6 needed), D2 (6 of 7), D3 (2 of 5), D4 (4 of 6)
- A total of 68 SSC parent delegates attended the elections with 42 schools represented.
- 142 total participants including 25 at-large attendees and 7 students
- Committee vacancies remaining: District 1: three (1 EL), District 2 (4, 2 EL), District 3 (1 EL),
   District 4 (2 EL)
- Special Elections for Districts 1 and 2 will be held at an LCAP member training on November 17;
   Special Elections for Districts 3 and 4 will be held at the December 16 General Meeting.












## LCAP Community Input Structures












# LCAP Student Advisory Subcommittee Structure
