






















Creation of the Middle School Athletic League

Launched Fall Sports

- Launches two fall sports, Co-Ed Flag Football and girls and boys cross country
- Over 350 middle school students participating
- Provided uniforms and equipment for all 20 participating middle schools
- Established regional sites within walking distance to the middle schools
- Partnered with Oakland Park and Recreation to provide officials
- Met and collaborated with principals and after-school coordinators
