(A)(1) Arrest by OSPD on OUSD School Sites for School Related Offenses

IOI SCHOOL MEIALEG OHEHSES

• Firearm on campus, 15, Black, Male (Skyline)

 Officer responded to a call that there was a student on campus who was possibly in possession of a firearm. The Officer arrived and attempted to detain the subject and conduct a pat search for weapons. Subject began to resist, officer observed a pistol in the subject waistband. Subject placed in handcuffs and the weapon was removed.

• Criminal Threats, Weapon on Campus, 15, Black, Male (Castlemont)

 Officer was on site when approached by a teacher of a student making threats to shoot up classroom. Officers pursued subject on foot. The officers detained the subject and located a black BB gun in the subject's backpack. Subject placed in handcuffs.

• Threat/Assault and Battery on a Police Officer, 17, Pacific Islander, Male

- Officers responded to assault on a Principal. Officer attempted to make contact with subject. The subject resisted arrest. The subject punched two officers multiple times as they attempted to place him under arrest. Subject threaten the officers, and school staff stating he was going to kill everyone once released from jail.
- Threat/Obstruct/Delay Arrest, 17,Black, Male (Castlemont)
 - Officers responded to high school on a report of an assault on a Principal and two former students on campus. Subject attempted to stop officers from arresting the other subject. The subject was arrested and placed into handcuffs. The subject then threatened to kill the officers and school staff.



(A)(2) Arrest by OSPD on OUSD School Sites for Non-School Related Offenses

- Arrest Warrant for Homicide, 15, Black, Male (McClymonds)
 - FBI Special Agents arrived at high school and made contact with OSPD with an Arrest Warrant for Murder for a subject attending the school. Officer assigned to the school requested to contact school staff, detain subject, and searched student prior to releasing him to FBI Task Force.

• Lewd and Lascivious Acts with a Minor, 17, Hispanic Male(Castlemont)

 OPD Officer made contact with OSPD Sergeant that he was on site to arrest a student for the crime of 288PC. Sergeant requested for OPD to wait outside and he would detain subject and release to OPD. OSPD searched and handcuffed the student and released subject to the custody of OPD. OPD contacted subject's mother and advised her of the incident.

Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, 15, Asian, Male (Oakland High)

 OPD contacted OSPD regarding an active arrest warrant for a student. OSPD contacted the school administration and was informed that the student was in class. OPD responded to the school, student was taken out of class and reported to the office. OPD investigators took the student into custody without incident.

• Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, 15, Black, Male (Skyline)

 OPD contacted OSPD and advised that a student was wanted for conspiracy to commit robbery. OSPD contacted the school and student was at school. Student was taken from class and OSPD informed student of arrest warrant, arrested student and transported to OPD.

• Rape, 14, Black Male (Claremont Middle School)

OPD contacted OSPD bout a student with an active arrest warrant for the crime of Rape. OPD responded to school and was informed student was in school. OSPD coordinated with administration and student was arrested for warrant.
