Root Causes and Goals

Focus Area	Root Cause(s)	Goals (by June 9, 2017)
Increase School-Wide Attendance	 Students need stronger relationships with caring adults on campus. Students should be offered more engaging/relevant material. 	Increase attendance by five percent.
Literacy: Writing	 Teachers need more interdisciplinary training, including specific strategies for scaffolding techniques. 	Eighty-five percent of all graduates will shift at least one indicator on the writing assessment.
Pathway Development	 Stakeholders need increased knowledge of career pathway design for full pathway implementation. 	Implement a multidimensional pathway with tiered internships, concurrent & dual enrollments and professional skills for transition to college and career.
