September 26-October 1, 2016 is National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week.

Discussion
One paragraph summary of the scope of work. Oakland Adult & Career Education is an integral part of OUSD, Full Service Community School District, Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), empowering families and communities in Oakland.
Current features of Oakland Adult & Career Education include:

- Geographically accessible instruction to adults in 20 locations throughout Oakland, including OUSD K-12 school sites, community based organizations, Laney College and Merritt College
- 17% increased enrollment, 28% increased academic outcomes, after years of severe budget and program cuts.
- Spring 2016, Oakland Adult Education added the College & Career Readiness Pathway program (English as a Second Language, Adult Basic Education/Academic Transitions) to serve more adults in our community. This new program supplements the existing Adult Education programs: GED test preparation, ESL Family Literacy, Computer Family Literacy, and Project SEARCH (Career Technical Education).

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education has provided instruction to adults in the Oakland community since 1871, addressing issues of unemployment and immigration, and has been in the vanguard as a regional, state and national leader in Adult Education; and

WHEREAS, September 26-October 1, 2016 is National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education increased adult student enrollment by 17% and academic outcomes by 28% in 2015-16; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education provides a quality instructional program with credentialed teachers, and with accreditation renewal from the Western Association of Schools & College Accreditation (WASC) in May 2015; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education is an integral part of the district's strategic plan for full service community schools by providing parents with skills needed for parent engagement; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education is the component of the district's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) that provides literacy instruction to parents to support academic achievement for low income and English Learner students by integrating Common Core State Standards into GED and ESL Family Literacy instruction; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education, as a part of the Northern Alameda Consortium for Adult Education, is coordinating instruction and services with the Peralta Colleges, neighboring adult schools and community based organizations to better serve adult learners toward college and career; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education, is piloting integrated basic education and skills training (i-BEST) instruction with Laney College; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Adult & Career Education, provides geographically accessible instruction to adults in 20 locations throughout Oakland, including OUSD K-12 school sites, community based organizations, Laney College and Merritt College; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education does hereby proclaim September 26-October 1, 2016, as: "Oakland Adult & Career Education Week" and salute the students, teachers, classified staff and administrators of Oakland Adult & Career Education, honoring their service and accomplishments since 1871.
