The Board of Education at its Regular Meeting on Thursday, October 13, 2016, at approximately 6:00 P.M., (or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard) in **The Great Room, LaEscuelita Education Center, 1050 2nd Avenue, Oakland, CA 94606**, will hold the District's annual hearing on the Sufficiency of Textbooks and Instructional Materials. The Board, at the hearing, will take testimony from pupils, parents, and staff as to whether the District has sufficiently provided required textbooks and/or instructional materials to pupils at your site and each and every site in the District as of the end of the eighth week of school (October 14, 2016).

The Board, at the conclusion of the hearing on October 13, 2016, including consideration of the staff recommendation and testimony offered, must make findings as to whether there are

sufficient books and instructional materials at sites. If "Yes," in whole or in part, the Board will be able to so certify. If "No", in whole or in part, then the Board must determine said shortages and how the shortages are going to be immediately made up.

The pending staff preliminary recommendation to the Board is for "full "Yes" certification" based on the survey of your site and each and every site in the District. The Notice, preliminary or proposed 2016-17 Sufficiency of Textbook and Instructional Materials Report, for consideration and possible adoption by the Board, will be viewable, in the major languages, on the District's web site at http://ousd.org/domain/69) on Friday, September 30, 2016.

As part of the process, from today through October 13, 2016, please post the attached Notice of the Public Hearing at your school site or District office in the major language or languages of your pupil, or parent population in a location accessible to the public. You are not required to reproduce the Public Hearing Notice to send home by pupils, or distribute to employees, but only to post the Notice at your site in an accessible, visible location so that visitors, pupils, parents, guardians, caregivers and staff may read it and participate in the Hearing on October 13, 2016, if desired. The Notice is required to remain posted at your site through October 13, 2016.

(PLEASE USE ONLY REPLY, NOT REPLY ALL) Your email response will serve as part of the record (evidence) that the District has complied with legal requirements by taking appropriate steps to determine, to remedy any late discovery of shortages of pupil textbooks or instructional materials, if required and that the District is entitled to the appropriated state textbook and instructional materials funds to educate its pupils (and not have to return such funds or be assessed a substantial monetary penalty because District did not follow the statutory steps, including noticing and conducting the Hearing to insure that students have adequate textbooks and materials).

The potential penalty or loss in revenue to the District for not following all of the procedural, statutory steps described herein is in excess of \$3.2 million dollars in textbook and instructional materials monies or other revenue for our pupils. 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The Board, Superintendent Wilson, his Chiefs and I thank you in advance for your prompt, positive honoring of this request to post the required Notice and, by return email, letting me know that the posting at your site has been done.
