



AIPCS II Student Demographic Information (2015-2016; 2016-2017)







AIPCS II Comparative ELA and Math Performance Data (3rd-5th Grade)







AIPCS II Comparative ELA and Math Performance Data (6th-8th Grade)







AIPCS II Comparative Economically Disadvantaged Student Data (3rd-5th Grade)




