

Discussion:

Dear Mr. Nakadegawa:

As you requested, we propose to provide an appraisals of the above referenced properties consisting of two public elementary schools now occupied as Oakland Charter Schools. The purpose of the appraisal is to estimate the market value of each property as of a current date. The function and intended use of the reports is assist the Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) in evaluating the properties for possible disposition by sale to their respective charter school organizations.

Our analyses and conclusions will be communicated in a Summary Appraisal Report conforming to the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) and the Code of Professional Ethics of the Appraisal Institute, and will contain sufficient information for the reader to understand the methodology and conclusions contained therein.

Our fee to complete the above scope of work is \$5,500 per appraisal, or a total of \$11,000, payable upon delivery of our report in pdf format. The time frame for completion is three to four weeks from the date of authorization to proceed with this assignment.

We have information about the property from a prior consulting assignment completed for the City of Oakland, though this proposed appraisal is an entirely new assignment conforming to your requirements. Nevertheless, the data we have in file and our contacts at the City of Oakland will be very useful in support of a thorough and efficient process of completing the appraisal.

We will need the following information on each property to complete the appraisal:

- 1. Copy of legal description of subject properties, i.e. Preliminary Title Report
- 2. Copies of floor plans for all levels.
- 3. Copies of all leases in force.
- 4. History of major repairs and upgrades for the last five years, and list of anticipated repairs and proforma costs.
- 5. Contact person to facilitate inspection of property.
- 6. Any other information deemed pertinent to the appraisal.

If the above is acceptable, please print this proposal, sign, and return to us by fax or mail. Please do not hesitate to contact us if further clarification is required. We look forward to the opportunity to provide this service to you.
