**WHEREAS**, Ms. Warfield instills a love of writing as a vehicle for expression, communication and argumentation—to the point where one student in Ms. Warfield's English Language Development (ELD) class wrote, "Writing is like my friend. Paper loves it when I write on it. Writing is to express yourself even when you don't have anyone to listen."

**WHEREAS**, Frick Middle School Principal noted that "Ms. Warfield values student voice and instills the confidence in her students to genuinely express their ideas, thoughts and actions in a way that will improve society."

**WHEREAS**, Kimi Kean, Executive Officer for East Oakland schools, described Ms. Warfield as "a tremendous asset to Frick Middle School and a shining example of how relationships and rigor can create extraordinary outcomes for students."
