Prepare them with skills and knowledge they need to enroll in and succeed in college or trade school program. Understand and practice 21st. Century Skills.</p> <p>Internships and job shadowing opportunities are essential to the alignment of academic theory with career related applied learning opportunities. Most of the attached budget is focused on equipment and supplies and student study tours.</p>
<p>How will this grant be evaluated for impact upon student achievement?</p> <p>(Customized data design and technical support are provided at 1% of the grant award or at a negotiated fee for a community-based fiscal agent who is not including OUSD's indirect rate of 4.75% in the budget. The 1% or negotiated data fee will be charged according to an Agreement for Grant Administration Related Services payment schedule. This fee should be included in the grant's budget for evaluation.)</p>	<p>To graduate, students must produce and present a senior project that deals with a topic related to the Academy. The senior project requires students to work directly in fields of study. Moreover students are required to perform community service as a graduation requirement. As a CPA the primary focus for continuous quality improvement is with both our OUSD advisory committee and the advisory committee of the academy site. The advisory meetings that include school district and school administration personnel occur on a regular basis. The academy will develop best practices that motivate partners to commit to activities and provide their services upon request.</p>
