through June 30, 2014.

Background

Dr. Ozer's expertise is required to assist in the development of evaluation and statistical analyses of outcomes of the Collaborative Problem Solving program in order to determine its efficacy in decreasing challenging student behaviors, increasing student ability to cope with unsolved academic/social problems, and improving teacher capacity to manage challenging student behavior in the school environment. This project is aligned with the district mandate to develop alternatives to student suspensions as well as referrals to special education under the category of emotional disturbance.

Discussion

Through this MOU for services between OUSD and Elizabeth Ozer, Ph.D., San Francisco, CA, the latter will provide 24 hours of technical consultation in the areas of program design, statistical analysis, and evaluation of Collaborative Problem Solving Program. A. Data Analysis and Reporting

- 1. Psychological Services at OUSD will:
 - Continue to enter collected data and run statistical analyses of the data, as well as
 to enter ongoing data regarding participants that is gathered as a part of regular

district activities (grades, CST results, discipline and attendance, referral for Special Education Assessment).

2. Elizabeth Ozer, Ph.D. will:

Provide 24 hours of consultation broken down into: 4 hours for submission of renewal for approval of UCSF's Committee on Human Research to continue analysis of data and 20 hours post-evaluation feedback with ideas for data analysis and interpretation of statistical outcomes and reporting. Consultation will entail general feedback regarding the content of the project regarding analysis of project outcomes and ideas for dissemination.

III. SERVICE FEES AND ACCOUNTING

A. The following outline of servicing fees applies to this business activity:

24 hours @ \$125 per hour, totaling \$3,000 to be provided to Dr. Ozer by the Psychological Services at OUSD in two installments of \$1500 according to the following schedule and due upon receipt of consultant invoice:

IV. TERM OF UNDERSTANDING

The term of this agreement is for a period of at least one year from the date of signature and will continue until or unless either organization terminates this agreement through written notice to the other party.
