Background <i>A one paragraph</i> <i>explanation</i>	The 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Community School suspended its operations and closed effective January 24, 2014, with the intent to reoperat a future date. We further understand the reopening date is not currently known. The term of the charter for the 100 school was set by the District's Board of Education's action authorizing the charter. Therefore, the charter original term remains in effect but continues to run. By way of example only, as the charter term ends June 30, 2017, if the 100 sought to reopen September 2015, the remaining term of the charter would continue to Jun 30, 2017.				
Discussion One paragraph summary	Effective February 1, 2014, the Facilities and Operations Agreement by and between the District and the 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Charter Schools, approved by the Board of Education on June 13, 2012 (Enactmen # 12-1481) and amended on February 13, 2013 (Enactment # 13-0328), will terminate. The reason for the termination is the decision by the 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Charter Schools to cease operations as of January 25, 2014, (with plans to reopen at an unspecified date in the future). The District's future decision to agree to the reopening of the charter school will be conditioned upon repayment of outstanding debts, including approximately \$325,000 owed the District and demonstration of fiscal soundness of the structure of the school. The Marshall campus was vacated by the school effective February 28, 2014. The use of the school between February 1 and February 28 was under the Civic Center Act.

Dear Mr. Taylor and Mr. Bey:

Effective February 1, 2014, the District is terminating the Facilities and Operations Agreement by and between the Oakland Unified School District and the 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Charter Schools approved by the Board of Education on June 13, 2012 and amended on February 13, 2013. The reason for the termination is the decision by the 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Charter Schools to cease operations as of January 25, 2014 (with plans to reopen at a date in the future).

As the District has previously advised, because the charter school notified the District of its intent to cease operations, the District will not pursue at this time any of the available legal remedies (*e.g.* Notice of Concern, Notice of Violation) with respect to the school's charter. However, the District will condition the reopening of the school on repayment of this outstanding debt and demonstration of fiscal soundness of the structure of the school.

The District has agreed that in order to give the charter school sufficient time to complete closure, move items remaining at the Marshall campus and appropriately redistribute student records, the District will grant the 100 Black Men of the Bay Area Charter Schools authorization to continue to occupy the Marshall campus for the period from February 1, 2014 to February 28, 2014 under the Civic Center Act. Please review the attached application, sign and append a Certificate of Insurance naming the District as an additional insured in the amount of \$1,000,000 combined single limits. The signed application and certificate of insurance should be returned to me no later than Wednesday, February 12, 2014.
