Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding between Oakland Unified School District and City of Oakland. Services to be primarily provided to the Community Schools and Student Services Department for the period of August 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017.

Background A one paragraph explanation of why the consultant's

services are needed.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a relationship between OUSD and the City of Oakland to provide two 2.0 FTE MSW Case Managers, who meet the required qualifications per the City of Oakland Case Manager II job description, to address chronic absence throughout OUSD. The case managers will be managed and supervised by the City of Oakland. Their work will support the City's efforts to reduce truancy. Case Managers will support specific OUSD school sites and work with students who are chronically absent. They will work with students, families, teachers, school staff, and other resource organizations to help support students improve their attendance.

Discussion One paragraph summary of the scope of work. Approval by the Board of Education of a Memorandum of Understanding between the District and City of Oakland, Oakland, CA, for the latter to provide two MSW Case Managers to work at specific OUSD school sites to address chronic absence; a point person at the school site will serve as liaison, provide formal introduction to teachers, other school staff; ongoing participate on COST team, at staff meetings, school events and other activities; manager will be provided site-level access to Aeries from Principal and a work space to meet and work with students for the period of August 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017, at no cost to the District.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO REDUCE CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM AND INCREASE STUDENT ATTENDANCE FOR FISCAL YEARS 2015-2017

WHEREAS, efforts to reduce chronic absenteeism and improve school attendance are strongly aligned with the citywide goals to promote student success in school, to prevent violence and youth involvement in gangs, and to ensure a healthy transition to adulthood for all of Oakland's youth; and

WHEREAS, when students miss too much school it can cause them to fall behind academically and research shows that children chronically absent in kindergarten and 1st grade are much less likely to read at grade level by the end of 3rd grade; by 6th grade, chronic absences are a proven early warning sign for students at risk of dropping out of school; by 9th grade, good attendance can predict graduation rates even better then 8th grade test scores; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) has established district-wide targets to 1. Reduce chronic absence to 5% of students at every school, 2. Ensure that 85% of students attend school 95% of days annually, and 3. Reach an average daily attendance (ADA) rate of 98% at every school; and

WHEREAS, OUSD has identified strategies to address attendance including the provision of targeted support provided to schools with high rates of chronic absence to help build site capacity to manage attendance, engagement of families and the community around the importance of attendance, and the hiring of four case managers during the 2015-2016 school year to support ten elementary schools with high rates of chronic absenteeism, including two positions funded by the City of Oakland and two positions funded by OUSD; and

WHEREAS, the two City-funded case managers will be City employees hired by the City of Oakland and supervised by the Human Services Department's Children and Youth Services Division; and

WHEREAS, the two City-funded Case Managers are authorized positions that were included in the Fiscal Years (FY) 2015-2017 Adopted Budget funded by the General Purpose Fund (1010), Youth Services Organization (78251), Reduce Chronic Absenteeism Project (A490830); and

WHEREAS, section 504(l) of the City of Oakland Charter requires City Council approval for intergovernmental relations and contracts for joint governmental actions; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the OUSD for the purpose of establishing an agreement for the provision of two case workers funded and hired by the City of Oakland to help reduce chronic absenteeism and increase student attendance at school sites for the period FY 2015-2017; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized without returning to Council, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary for the above referenced MOU; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said MOU agreement shall be reviewed as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and copies will be filed in the Office of the City Clerk.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CITY OF OAKLAND AND OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

I. Parties and Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is to establish a relationship between Oakland Unified School District ("OUSD") and the City of Oakland ("CITY") to enable CITY and OUSD to provide the services as described herein at the designated school site(s) as provided in Section II below of this MOU. City shall provide services at no cost to OUSD, OUSD students or OUSD parents.

II. Program Sites

Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties, the School(s) governed by this agreement will be selected by the Community Schools and Student Services ("CS & SS") Department.

A. Time Commitment Schedule

The time commitment and schedule shall be determined by each School site not to exceed agreed upon hours per week.

B. Space

CITY does not require space at each school site but may require access to confidential space as needed and as it is available while CITY visits school sites to meet with families. CITY will have workspace and phone at the CS&SS central Office location. OUSD will also provide laptop, district email, address and district ID badge to CITY Case Managers.

C. School sites will provide the following:

- A point person at the school site to serve as liaison to the case manager.
- Approval to site-level access Aeries from Principal.
- A formal introduction to teachers and other school staff and ongoing participation as needed to staff meetings, school events, and other activities.
- Participation on COST teams and/or attendance teams.
- Private space with computer access to meet and work with students.

III. CITY Responsibilities/Scope of Services

A. Two case managers will be hired by the City of Oakland. The case managers will be supervised and managed by the City of Oakland. Their work will support the City of Oakland's efforts to reduce truancy. Case managers will support specific schools sites and work with students who are chronically absent. They will work with students, families, teachers, school staff, and other resource organizations to help support students improve their attendance.

The CITY shall hire case managers who possess the required qualifications per the City of Oakland Case Manager II job description.

- B. CITY shall ensure that all CITY personnel, including subcontractors, will comply with any policy and systems in place at OUSD and School(s). This includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - 1. **Drug and Smoke Free**—No drugs, alcohol, and/or smoking are allowed at any time in any buildings and/or grounds on OUSD property. No students, staff, visitors, agencies, or subcontractors are to use drugs on these School(s).
 - 2. **Anti-Discrimination**—It is the policy of OUSD that in connection with CITY's services in this MOU there shall be no discrimination against any employee engaged in the work because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, religious creed, physical disability, medical condition, marital status, sexual orientation, gender, or age. Therefore, the CITY agrees to comply with applicable Federal and California laws.

- 3. **Family Education Rights and Privacy Act**—CITY agrees to comply with state and federal laws, including the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, commonly known as FERPA, related to the confidentiality of pupil and personnel records.
- C. Required Documents—Ensure that all CITY personnel who will be on OUSD premises have been: (a) fingerprinted; (b) submitted to a criminal background check via Livescan or a similar service as required by the Education Code, and (c) taken a tuberculosis test. Please see Section IV for the relevant documentation that is required.

D. Insurance—

CITY shall procure and maintain at all times during the performance of this MOU, Workers' Compensation Insurance in conformance with the laws of the State of California. Employers' Liability Insurance shall not be less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per accident or disease.

CITY shall maintain Commercial General Liability insurance, including automobile coverage with limits of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage. The coverage shall be primary as to OUSD and shall name OUSD as an additional insured. Evidence of insurance must be attached. Endorsement of OUSD as an additional insured shall not affect OUSD's rights to any claim, demand, suit or judgment made, brought or recovered against CITY. The policy shall protect CITY and OUSD in the same manner as though each were separately issued. Nothing in said policy shall operate to increase the Insurer's liability as set forth in the policy beyond the amount or amounts shown or to which the Insurer would have been liable if only one interest were named as an insured. OUSD will accept Certificate of Self Insurance in lieu of an Acord form.

- E. **Communication** CITY shall communicate with School(s) and OUSD staff, both formally and informally, to ensure, to the best of the program's ability, that the CITY'S services are aligned with the School(s) and OUSD's mission and objectives and are adequately meeting student's needs. At the request of School(s) or OUSD staff, provide reasonable data and information to students participating in the CITY'S program.
- F. Confidentiality—CITY shall maintain strict confidentiality of all information about individual students received under this MOU and will not disseminate such information without the express written consent of OUSD. CITY will comply with FERPA, and will be allowed to use the data received to solicit funding to continue to expand its services/program, so long as there is no information from which the identity of any student in the CITY'S program as a participant could be made.

IV. Required Documents

- A. Attach a letter from CITY on CITY letterhead verifying that CITY employees providing services under this MOU have been Fingerprinted/Criminal Background Checked and have TB clearance.
- B. **Insurance**—see Section **III(D)** for specifications. Please attach documentation of proof of insurance.

V. Responsibilities of Oakland Unified School District

- A. Staff Contact—OUSD shall connect case managers to school sites and provide ongoing support, professional development and problem solving. Case manager workloads will be coordinated by the Coordinator of Attendance and Discipline Support Services. CITY employees will work assigned hours at each school. Work hours will be agreed upon by the site administrator and the Community Schools and Student Services Department. The CITY employees, will meet regularly with the Coordinator at a frequency to be agreed upon by Community Schools and Student Services and the CITY.
- B. **Data** OUSD shall ensure that CITY employees assigned under this MOU have reasonable access to student data to inform case management.
 - At the sole discretion of OUSD, provide CITY employees assigned under this MOU access to student data for identified students at School(s) including, but not limited to, attendance, discipline, grades, SRI or Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (Dibels) or whatever reading assessments that are being used to track students reading levels.
 - 2. Provide CITY employees assigned under this MOU with student information reasonably necessary to provide services consistent with the CITY'S services and to evaluate the impact of its service on students at School(s).
 - 3. The CITY will work with site Attendance Teams and Coordination of Services Teams (COST) and other school site staff and partners to provide needed support to students.
- C. Coordination of the work of Case Managers will be provided by the OUSD Coordinator of Attendance and Discipline Support Services.

VI. Duration

This MOU is for the school years 2015 - 2016 and 2016 - 2017.

VII. Termination

Either party may terminate this MOU at any time, without cause, with 60 days written notice to the other party. This agreement may be amended by mutual consent of the parties. All amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.

VIII. Hold Harmless/Indemnity

Each party to this MOU agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other for and from any claims, causes of action, or any other proceeding of any type or kind that is made against the other where such claim, cause of action or other proceeding arises from the conduct, act, omission, or commission by the other party.
