Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1617-0039 - Support - Proposition 56 - Cigarette Tax To Fund Healthcare, Tobacco Use Prevention, Research, and Law Enforcement. Initiative Constitutional Amendment and Statute.

Background

Research has determined that smoking is a preventable cause of death in California and in the nation; that 90% or more young people begin smoking as teenagers; that greater efforts need to be made to dissuade and to prevent this health crisis occurring among young people.

I am asking my colleagues, for reasons enumerated in Resolution No. 1617-0039, to support Proposition 56 so that new health programs are established, among others, for California pupils that provide more health prevention, intervention services and will, in general, hopefully, dissuade or diminish the use of tobacco products by the general population because of the known harmful health effects.

SUPPORT - PROPOSITION 56 - CIGARETTE TAX TO FUND HEALTHCARE, TOBACCO USE PREVENTION, RESEARCH, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AND STATUTE

WHEREAS, smoking is the leading preventable cause of death in California and Nationally; and

WHEREAS, 90 percent of smokers start as teens; and

WHEREAS, over 16,000 children in California get hooked on smoking every year, and half of the teens who start will die from smoking related illness; and

WHEREAS, for every 10 percent increase in the cost of a pack of cigar ettes, teen smoking drops by up to 6.5 percent; and

WHEREAS, teen e-cigarette (vaping) use tripled between 2013 and 2014 and continues to grow at an exponential rate; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 56, the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 will prevent teens from becoming addicted to tobacco; and

WHEREAS, every year, smoking costs California taxpayers billions of dollars, including \$3.5 billion spent annually through Medi-Cal to treat smoking-related diseases; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 56 will reduce smoking rates and reduce long-term healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 56 will increase the tax on a pack of cigar ettes sold in California from 87 cents a pack to \$2.87, and place equivalent taxes on other to bacco products containing nicotine, like e- cigar ettes; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 56 will raise approximately \$2.5 billion annually, 85% of which will fund healthcare programs including millions for new health care programs for California schools; and

WHEREAS, these programs include Medi-Cal which is the primary medical care for the majority of California's school children, smoking prevention programs at our schools through grants administered by the California Department of Education, research on tobacco-related diseases including cancer, heart and lung disease through the University of California, increasing medical residency programs for our students graduating from California medical schools; and

WHEREAS, the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 is supported by State Superintendent of Public Instruction Tom Torlakson, the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network, the American Heart Association, the American Lung Association in California, the California Medical Association, the California Dental Association, the California Hospital Association, and the Service Employees international Union;

NOW, THEREFORE, BEIT RESOLVED that the Oakland Unified School District strongly supports Proposition 56, the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 and urges Californians to vote YES to take a stand to promote the health of our students and save California lives.
