PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project covers various improvements to specific areas at Frick Impact Academy. There will be three phases of construction. There will be separate budgets for each phase and they will be bid separately.

- Phase 1 is complete with painting of the interior and exterior of selected buildings on campus, installation of new cabinets and/or furniture in specific classrooms, and demolition of existing portables on campus.
- Phase 2 will be an asphalt overlay of the existing playground and the installation of a new synthetic turf field.
- Phase 3 will be various site improvement work including painting, plumbing, carpentry and lighting.
- The budget for the school upgrades is \$4.0M.
- The budget for the new synthetic turf field is \$1.0M.
