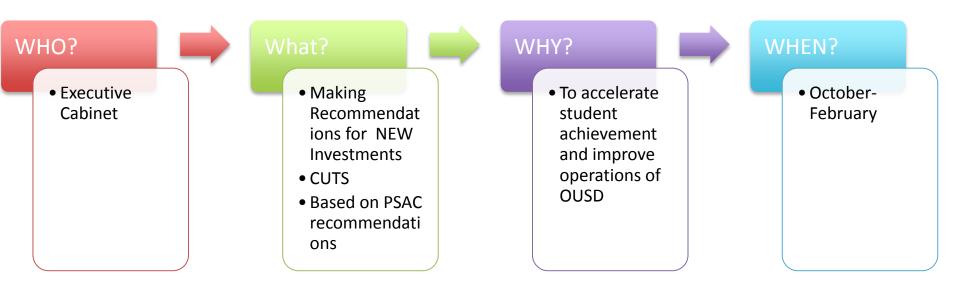








Budget Prioritization: 14-15 and 15-16



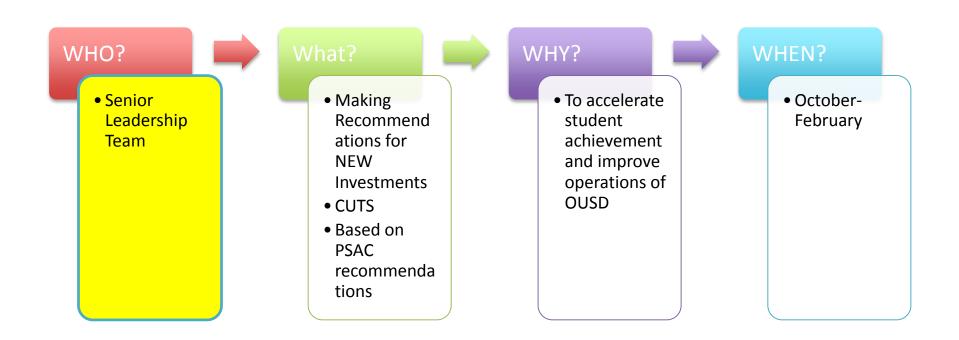
