Annual Budget Plan



Requirements

The Annual Budget Plan must include:

Administrative Costs of the Plan



- Services to Students with Severe and Low Incidence Disabilities
- Services to Students with Mild to Moderate Disabilities
- Supplemental Aids and Services to Meet the Needs of Students with Disabilities in General Education









Annual Service Plan



Requirements

The Annual Service Plan must include:

- A description of Special Education Services, including Related Services
- The physical location where the services may be provided
- Additionally, the Annual Service Plan must demonstrate that all students with disabilities have access to the services identified in their Individual Education Programs (IEPs)
