ACTION REQUESTED:

Adoption by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1617-0246 - Measure N - College and Career Readiness Commission - Education Improvement Plan Implementation Findings and Assessments To Date/Grant Awards - 2017-2018 School Year.

BACKGROUND:

The Measure N Commission over the last year made selected visits to school sites, received monthly reports from its staff and held hearings on May 2, 3, 4, 16, 17, 18, with schools, to determine progress made over the last two years in implementing Measure N. Consequently, based on established criteria applied fairly and equitably to each school site, progress made and status during the last year-two years, incorporated in each school sites assessment report, the Commission, as of May 20, 2017, designated a school as either Fully Implemented, Developing and Implementing or Planning regarding implementation of Measure N. A link to each school's Assessment is embedded in the Resolution.

Consequently, the Commission **unanimously** adopted and recommends the Board of Education approve, for 2017-2018, the "High School Education Improvement Plan Implementation Assessment Awards," approved by the Measure N Commission on June 20, 2017, as follows:

The Measure N Commission finds that a majority of the schools have made or are making significant progress with required steps to implement Measure N. The Commission also finds that about a third of the schools assessed are either beginning implementation or require stronger support and/or remediation steps toward full implementation, including, in several instances, refocusing and replanning of steps to successfully implement Measure N.
