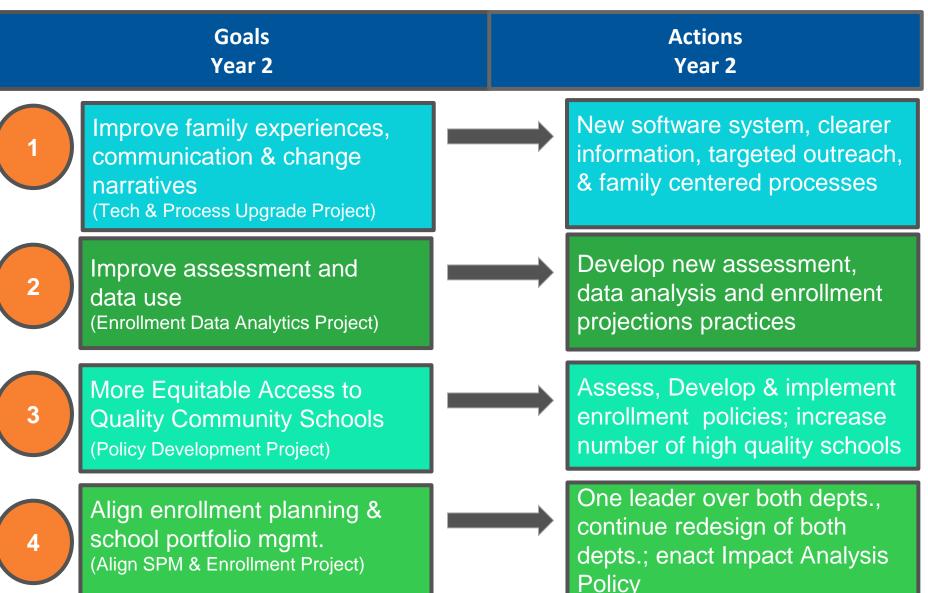

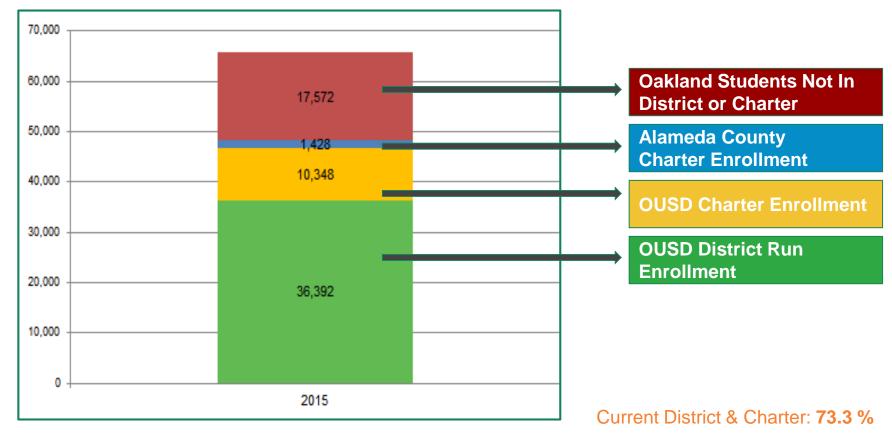

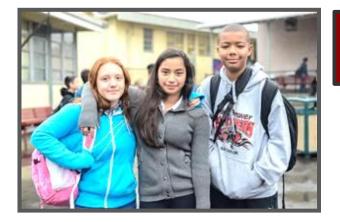
* Capture rate analysis includes only children living within Oakland; it does not account for students living outside Oakland attending Oakland schools.
