Working Together to Put Students First

Dear Oakland Community,

A few weeks ago, I had the pleasure of visiting the King Estates campus in our district.

If you're not familiar, we have a few schools located at King Estates, which is located in the footbills of East Oakland. There's Rudsdale and Sojourner Truth, which are OUSD Community Schools. Also located on the campus is Bay Area Technology School (commonly known as "BayTech") which is an OUSD charter school.

Now, I've said from the day that I arrived in Oakland that what matters most to me is the quality of a school, not who operates it. Every student who attends a charter school or a district school is an Oakland public school student. It's up to us as adults to put aside politics and agendas and work together in the interest of children.

And that's exactly what we see on the sing Estates campus-leaders who collaborate, create a culture of high expectations for students and teachers, share resources, and sacrifice for one another.

"We believe that all of our kids can be successful," says Willie Thompson, principal of Rudsdale and Sojourner Truth. "Essentially, what we have here are full-service community schools where kids have options."

I am in schools every week as part of my commitment to visit every school across our district and engage with teachers, students, leaders, and community. I've visited the

King Estates campus a number of times. There is so much energy and action therestudents engaged with technology and blended learning, and being taught important skills that will serve them well as responsible adults. I love that there are graduations throughout the year at Rudsdale and students are constantly being celebrated.

The leadership shown by the two principals on this campus, Hayri Hatipoglu of BayTech and Mr. Thompson (pictured in the photo above), is an illustration of collaboration at a high level. Above all, they serve every child who steps foot on that campus, no matter what school they may attend.

"We're a family here together," Principal Hatipoglu says. "When there's an issue, it's not about 'them' or 'us' - it's about all of us."

Principal Thompson agrees. "We keep in mind that we're here for students, and look for ways to leverage our resources," he says. "We see it as a great opportunity. I don't get other."

There is one entrance for students on to the King Estates campus, where students are greeted by School Security Officers (SSOs) who serve the entire campus. Students share the gym, the field, and the new garden. They have teams in the same basketball league and compete against one another in soccer.





Achievement Level Distribution







Achievement Level Distribution




