Planning and Piloting • \$525 per pupil	X	In response to feedback, we have identified a pathway linked to a CTE industry sector and initiated a master schedule shift to create a 4-year technical sequence for all students. We will roll out our pilot in the 2018-2019 school year with over 50% of our student population enrolled in a CTE course. Our self-assessment is that this represents a pilot year prior to full implementation with 100% students enrolled in CTE in 2019-2020.
