Graduate Outcomes	Increase by 5% the number of Dewey students graduating each school year	Dewey's goal is to graduate between 40 to 50 students in December and 90 to 100 students in June each school year.
Post-Secondary Readiness	Increase the amount of students that graduate with dual enrollment credit and work based learning experience by 4-6%, each year.	Dual Enrollment opportunities are on-track or ahead of projections as we have added a Counseling 201 course each hexmester. We are offering additional DE Courses during Expanded Learning that align with our pathway. Also, Concurrent Enrollment opportunities. Due to WBL going out on Maternity Leave, we are not meeting our goals currently to increase WBL experiences (jobs, internships, etc)
Climate and Culture	Increase the attendance rate by 5%	Implement
Rigorous Academics	Increase by 5% the amount of students who have demonstrated growth on the SRI; Increase the amount of time students interact with text and writing.	
Pathway Development	By June 8, 2018 the Health, Fitness, and Trade Pathway is clear to students, teachers, staff, families, and community members. Additionally, 75 percent of all students participate in a pathway experience: project, internship, mentorship, job shadow, dual enrollment course, etc.
