Goal 1: Graduates are college and career ready.

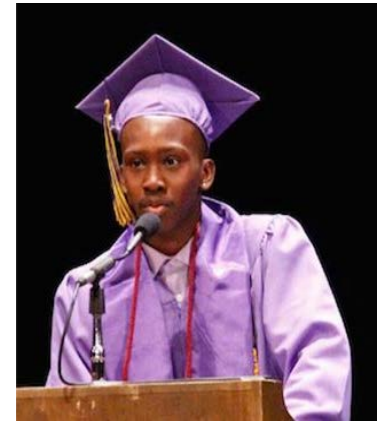
Goal 2: Students are proficient in state academic standards.
