WHEREAS, the staff members who were in the office, momentarily stunned by Mr. Metz' situation, quickly stepped into action: called 911; checked Mr. Metz' breathing and pulse; told the 911 dispatcher his heart had stopped and, upon instruction from the dispatcher, used the office-based defibrillator to restart his heart and began CPR; and

WHEREAS, firefighters and paramedics arrived quickly and took over administration of emergency treatment; and

WHEREAS, paramedics took Mr. Metz to the hospital, where he remained unconscious for several days and his prognosis was not good; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Metz subsequently became conscious, underwent major heart surgery and began to recover quickly; and

WHEREAS, attending physicians told Mr. Metz he likely would not have survived had it not been for the quick action of the Skyline High School staff; and
