- C. Tuberculosis Screening: CONTRACTOR is required to screen employees and agents who will be present at OUSD sites during the current school year. CONTRACTOR affirms that each person has current proof of negative TB testing on file and TB results are monitored. Please see Section IV for the relevant documentation that is required.

Harbor House seeks to help youth overcome the academic, emotional and physical challenges they face through our provided services:

Academic tutoring to develop math, reading and writing skills, including a 1-on-1 intervention program and small group help with homework and supplemental Harbor House work to help further academic achievement.

Sports activities, such as hockey, basketball, and soccer, through which we develop character, friendships, and respect for one another.

Snack time, which offers us an opportunity to eat together and talk about our day in a safe and loving environment.

Volunteer-led clubs such as art, theater, cooking and science, which allow for others to share their lives and passions with our youth. In the Spring 2017 quarter, 13 discrete clubs were offered.

Field trips designed to broaden the worldview and horizons of our youth beyond the immediate environment of the city.

Our expected outcomes are:

100% of youth have access to enriching activities where they can discover and develop their gifts.

75% of students in our Reading Clinic program increase reading level by at least one grade level each year.

85% of students self-identify as liking and wanting to learn and achieve academically.

The letter below outlines Harbor House's Statement of Qualifications for candidacy as an OUSD Partner for 2017-2020.

In the past 40 years, Harbor House has served more than 100,000 people in economic and educational development. Over the years, programs developed from backyard tutoring to a formalized tutoring program; volunteer-led English classes for adults to a professional ESL program; emergency food and clothing distributed from boxes on shelves to a fully stocked kitchen and thrift store; out-of-neighborhood kids clubs to an in-house after-school program; teens hanging out to teens working as interns.

In order to respond to the needs of youth in our community with flexibility, love, and discipline, our programs are based on a family model — one that works, plays, and eats together. Participants in our elementary after-school program are guided, assisted, and encouraged by our older high school interns and Harbor House staff and volunteers.

Some of our successes include:

- 8 students enrolled in our 2015-2016 Excel Reading Clinic reported at least one grade level increase in reading over the year.
- 90% average attendance throughout the year.
