The All City Council Student Union Governing Board is excited to share with you all what we have been up to. This summer we spent time getting each of our elected ACCSU Governing Board members oriented on their roles and responsibilities for each position. We also reviewed helpful resources to the new, wonderful, and fresh All City Council members. On July 17 and 23rd, All City Council prepared for the OUSD All Principals Leadership Institute. We went over roles that align with our current strengths. To furthermore comprehend the importance of the event, we went through Roger Hart's ladder of Youth Engagement, Student Engagement Standards, and the OUSD Student and Family Engagement Theory of Action. This training was then applied on July 30th, all ACC members reported to the Principal's Leadership Institute to share the importance of student and adult partnerships while maintaining a relationship where both parties are not manipulating, using, and/or controlling one another.
