## Enrollment Update

## Executive summary

- The $20^{\text {th }}$ Day Enrollment count for 2018-2019 was 36,235:
- 34,833 Non-Special Day Class (SDC)
- 1,402 Special Day Class
- This year's 20 day count showed a decline relative to prior years, potentially driven by the early start of school; by grade span, elementary schools and middle schools experienced the largest percentage decline
- District-wide, our day 20 count was about $1 \%$ lower than projections, in line with historical accuracy levels
- In the future, we will move to using CALPADS enrollment data as opposed to 20 day counts as the basis for enrollment projections


## Total 20th Day Enrollment counts have declined by $1.7 \%$ since last year

Special Day Class: Term used to describe a self contained special education class which provides services to students with intensive needs that cannot be met by the general education program, resource specialist program, or designated instruction services program. Classes typically consist of more than $50 \%$ of the student's day. *The SDC counts process is currently under review and we are continuing to refine the process to ensure greater consistency and accuracy.

Note: Projection accuracy is impacted by both external factors (gentrification, housing, charter activity) and internal factors (decisions about programs approved after October of each year).

## 20 day Counts and CALPADS are 2 different ways of measuring enrollment

|  | 120 day counts | 2 CALPADS |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Definition | - Enrollment on the $20^{\text {th }}$ day of school (e.g., 9/10/2018) | - Enrollment on the $1^{\text {st }}$ Wednesday in October <br> - (10/3/2018); represents the state official count |
| Methodology | - Principal and clerical team conduct physical count students; they submit to enrollment office | - Clerical, welcome center, and administrative staff enter in enrollment data in Aeries; in addition, database sync from SEIS and MOSAIC; this information gets sent to CDE |
| What's included in terms of enrollment data? | - Non-SDC counts by school and grade <br> - SDC counts by school <br> - Total counts by school | - Official enrollment count of students by school by grade |
| Used for | - Teacher consolidation decisions and contractual obligation (10/1); admin and clerical staffing decisions <br> - Alignment to Aeries | - LCFF supplemental and concentration funding and distribution, measure G distribution <br> - A variety of restricted resources <br> - Enrollment projections (moving forward) |

## Benefits of using CALPADS for enrollment projections

- CALPADS represents official numbers that we submit to the state
- CALPADS is how LCFF S\&C dollars are currently distributed, which would provide more internal consistency
- Using CALPADS is standard practice of other districts

We will be moving to using CALPADS for enrollment projections in the future

## Day 20 was one week earlier this year relative to prior years

| Year | First day of <br> school | Date of day <br> 20 | Labor Day | Time between <br> Labor Day and <br> Day 20 |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 2015 | $8 / 24 / 2015$ | $9 / 21 / 2015$ | $9 / 7 / 2015$ | 2 weeks |
| 2016 | $8 / 22 / 2016$ | $9 / 19 / 2016$ | $9 / 5 / 2016$ | 2 weeks |
| 2017 | $8 / 21 / 2017$ | $9 / 18 / 2017$ | $9 / 4 / 2016$ | 2 weeks |
| 2018 | $8 / 13 / 2018$ | $9 / 10 / 2018$ | $9 / 3 / 2016$ | 1 week |

...as a result, the time between Labor Day and Day 20 was only 1 week (compared to 2 weeks in prior years)

## We may not have captured the additional growth in enrollment that happens in mid-Late September
